

### From Your Pastor

This weekend is the last weekend that one of our seminarians for this summer, Deacon Julio Granados, will be with us.

He will be going home to his native Colombia for five weeks before returning to St, Mary's Seminary in Baltimore to begin his fourth and final year of theological studies before he is ordained to the priesthood next spring. We wish Deacon Julio well as he begins this new school year and pray that it will be an enriching one for him spiritually as well as academically.

Back on June 29<sup>th</sup>, we celebrated the solemnity of two of the Church's most prominent figures, Saints Peter & Paul. In a homily that he gave on that date in 2020, Pope Francis had the following to say: ....."It is pointless, even tedious, for Christians to waste their time complaining about the world, about society, about everything that is not right. Complaints change nothing. Let us remember that complaining is the second door that closes us off from the Holy Spirit.... The first is narcissism, the second discouragement, the third pessimism. Narcissism makes you look at yourself constantly in a mirror; discouragement leads to complaining and pessimism to thinking everything is dark and bleak. These three attitudes close the door to the Holy Spirit. Those Christians (of Sts. Peter's & Paul's time) did not cast blame; rather, they prayed. In that community, no one said: 'If Peter had been more careful, we would not be in this situation.' No one. Humanly speaking, there were reasons to criticize Peter, but on one criticized him. They did not talk about Peter behind his back; they talked to God. We today can ask: 'Are we protecting our unity, our unity in the Church, with prayer? Are we praying for one another?' What would happen if we prayed more and complained less, if we had a more tranquil tongue?"

# WORD & 16<sup>th</sup> Sunday in DEED Ordinary Time

The story is told of an old man who walks along the beach after the tide has gone out. He picks up stranded starfish and tosses them back into the sea. A young man watches him for a while, and then says, "You cannot hope to save all these starfish. What you are doing means nothing to them." The old man pauses for a moment and then says, "It means something to this one" and continues on his way.

Jesus does not heal the world in one gigantic display of power. He does not preach the Gospel to everyone at one time. He meets people where they are, addressing them in their situation and in their need. He looks into their eyes and offers Himself as well as His message. It is a life-changing encounter for many, and an unsolved mystery for others. To those whose lives and hearts He touched, it made a big difference.

The value of what we do is not determined by the number of people we reach, or the scope of the work we do. Each encounter, each act of kindness, each moment of love means a great deal to the one who receives it. It also has the infinite possibility to change the world, to bring life, and to lead someone to Heaven. The mission of Christ is entrusted to us all and is measured by love, one person at a time.

### FROM DEACON PAUL AUDETTE:

Henri Nouwen Speaks to us through his Letters



In the summer of 1984, Mark Hatfield, a Republican senator from Oregon who had a reputation for independence and integrity, came under suspicion in an ethics investigation. Henri writes to Hatfield about how to handle the injustice and pain of being unfairly accused. This is Part III of his letter. (taken from "Love, Henri: Letters on the Spiritual Life"):

Dear Senator Hatfield,

... I realize that this is one of the hardest periods of your life, since one tries to do harm to you in the center of your being. But it also is the true hour of faith and fidelity. It is time of dying with Christ. It is dark and lonely, but when you know that your heart is united with the heart of Christ the powers of darkness will not destroy you. If within a few months you will be re-elected and all investigations will have restored your full honor, you can be very grateful but do not have to be exuberant saying: "I always told you so." But if you will not be re-elected and not receive the satisfactory response you expect, you may feel sad but do not have to become depressed, resentful or bitter. In both situations you can become more compassionate, that is, a man who suffers with Christ and thus gains the life that even death cannot destroy ...




### GRANDPARENTS!!






