This week we will interrupt the Discourse on the Bread of Life in the

Gospel of John to focus on the Assumption of our Blessed Mother Mary into heaven. The Assumption of Mary was defined as a doctrine of faith by Pope Pius XII in 1950. In the encyclical that he wrote at that time, Pope Pius also cited Mary's intimate connection with Jesus, her Son, and his victory over sin and death. From the beginning of her life to its end, Mary's life was one of faith and prayer. Her life is a good example for us to follow because our life of faith has to be sustained in prayer, both personal and communal. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (ccc 1123) tells us that our participation in the liturgy of the Mass both expresses and nourishes our faith. Making time for prayer in our personal lives enables us to appreciate God's abiding presence and places us in deeper communion with him. By following Mary's exam-

ple of a routine of prayer, a habit of praise and a total submission to God's will, we will join her in her heavenly reward.

Henri Nouwen Speaks to us through his Letters



Henri writes a letter of consolation to Jurjen Beumer on the death of his father. (taken from "Love, Henri: Letters on the Spiritual Life"):

Dear Jurgen,

... I am very moved by what you write about the death of your father. I am so happy that you had a good and cordial farewell. I realize how important that is for you, especially since you told me a little about the tensions in your relationship with your father. Somehow I am convinced that this is a very important moment in your life, a moment in which you are facing your own mortality in a new way and where your father will become a new companion in your own journey. I am deeply convinced that the death of those whom we love always is a death for us, that is to say, a death that calls us to deepen our own basic commitments and to develop new freedom to proclaim what we most believe in. Mourning is a process in which you are, so to say, freed from old bonds but in which new bonds, more spiritual bonds, are being made ...




