

From Your Pastor

Today I share with you some excerpts from an article on Holy Communion written by Fr. Ronald Rolheiser who is a prolific writer on Catholic Christian spirituali-

"Being fed with the bread of life is one of the meanings of the Eucharist; we are meant to receive this food from heaven frequently to sustain us on our own journey. Being nourished by the Eucharist means more than receiving communion at Mass. The bread of life is meant to feed us in other ways. We aren't just called to receive the Eucharist in church. We are called to be a Eucharistic people. The Body of Christ comprises three realities: the person of Jesus, the Eucharist, and the body of believers. And this latter component, the body of believers, which is us, is just as real and just as physical as is the person of Jesus and the Eucharistic species. St. Paul tells us that we 'are' the Body of Christ...Paul affirms clearly the we 'are' Christ's body, as real and as physical as is the historical Body of Jesus. So we too, the Christian community, are the Bread of Life. At the Eucharist, then, it is not just bread and wine that are transubstantiated; so too is the congregation. When the priest pronounces the words of consecration, he is not just asking God to turn bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ; he is asking that the congregation be turned into the Body of Christ....And so the bread of life comes to us in various ways. Jesus nourishes us whenever we pray to him; the Eucharist feeds us with the bread of life whenever we partake of it; and the community of the faithful also functions as Eucharist. The love, friendship, support and care we give to others and receive from others is also communion." St. Thomas Aguinas, one of the Fathers of the Church, said that when we withhold a compliment from someone who deserves it, it is a sin because we are withholding food which that person needs to live on.

Henri struggled with depression throughout his life. In this letter, he asks for support from his friend Brock. He writes from a retreat center for clergy, where he has been sent to recuperate from emotional and physical exhaustion triggered by a falling out with a friend.

(taken from "Love, Henri: Letters on the Spiritual Life"):

Dear Brock,

...I really need your prayers and support at this time because I find myself in a very hard place. During the past few months so much physical and emotional fatigue has built up in me that the community decided to give me a month of rest, but you know how during periods of rest sometimes the demons are very active. I am particularly mourning because of a broken friendship and am still not able to find the strength to let the mourning set me free. It is so hard to let go of someone you really care for deeply and to recognize that you are not the person who can offer the support and love that he needs... "Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted." I really have to meditate on these words more than ever and how hard it is to "let go."...




