## FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK



Dear Parents,

This is probably a good time to remind our community of a few things pertaining to weather and communication in order to keep everyone up to date and safe! We try our very best to keep our families informed but are sometimes surprised at the number of people that say they do not read the newsletter or emails. I cannot express enough that those are your first line of communication. Step one is to make sure your RenWeb contact information is current. If you are not receiving alerts or regular communication on your phone or email, please go to your account and check what you have entered. You have the power to make changes as to where and how you receive our alerts. Please do not rely on second-hand information or social media, since we know not everyone is on those sites. Here are a few tips and reminders during the second half of the year (especially this year with all the crazy weather!).

- 1. SLCS will do our best to notify families as soon as possible to the school closing, dismissing early or starting late. The decision to close school is not taken lightly and involves checking with the Parish, Pastor, Weekday Program, local school districts and Catholic Schools Office. We do not automatically close if FBISD closes and appreciate your patience as we attempt to make the best decision possible for our families. Since many of you come from different parts of the city, we totally understand if it is not safe for you to drive in. Please use your best judgement. Keep in mind that we will always try to have school if the majority of our staff and students can make it in order to avoid having to make up school days during the holidays.
- 2. If you do rely mainly on social media, please check the school Facebook page and Website first before the grade level pages or other resources. Our amazing Communications Coordinator, Mrs. Adriana Gutierrez has her hands full sending out alerts, posting information and contacting the local TV Stations once I make the call. It is usually done in a matter of minutes, but we understand that it can seem like an eternity when you are waiting.
- 3. On cold days, our rule is to take the student outdoors unless it is raining. Children need time to run around and release their energy, so we will make all attempts to have outside recess when possible. Please send your child with the appropriate outerwear daily. Recently I have noticed many students coming in with short sleeves and not even a sweater or sweatshirt. Don't forget that on ECC, students travel outside in the courtyard several times a day in order to go to lunch and outclass.
- 4. Only official SLCS sweatshirts, sweaters and jackets are allowed to be worn inside the school building. Students are asked to take off any non-St. Laurence outerwear while in the hall and in the classrooms. These can be put on again when going outside.
- 5. PLEASE put your child's name in all outerwear, especially now when we are without a uniform supplier! So many brand new jackets and sweatshirts are missing and are not labeled!
- 6. Lastly, the Google calendar is the official school calendar and we keep it updated regularly, so please check there on a regular basis.

Well, I hope that there will be no more major weather events this year! This has to be one for the history books and we will certainly never forget 2017-2018. Thank you for all the support so far this year and please stay warm!
