Dear Saints Parents,

We had a lot of fun coming to school in our pajamas on Monday, so thank you again for your generosity with the Annual Fund and Auction this year. We are blessed with such supportive families that work with us as partners in ensuring we are able to provide the very best for our students. Thanks to all of you that volunteer through PTO, Booster and School Board each year, as this allows us to continue educating students, while providing enrichment opportunities for their bodies, minds, and spirits. I cannot thank our amazing board presidents and their dedicated groups enough for tirelessly working alongside the staff throughout a pandemic year. Thank you PTO Presidents Jennifer Reyes, Mary Phillippi; School Board President Lionel Martin and Booster President Jessica Barry, along with all your dedicated board members and volunteers for your unfailing support this year. Whenever there was a need, whether it involved students or staff members, you made sure it was filled. We felt the love and the prayers and it sustained us.


