COVID-19 UPDATES

Confirmed positive cases of students/staff in the school building are reported weekly in order to keep you informed as to positive cases in our school. Emails will still be sent directly to specific departments (ECC/Elem & MS), grade levels, or classrooms. If we suspect spread within a class/grade level or department, everyone in that group <u>may be required to wear masks</u>.

Current numbers of confirmed positive cases in the school building are listed below. This data does not include other family members or those that have not been at school in the time period where other students could be identified as "close contact". Our protocol for close contact within the home is different for in-school due to the much higher rate of spread from familial contact.

Due to the low number of cases and spread, masks are now optional for both adults and students inside the buildings. Masks are optional for our All School Liturgy on Fridays.
