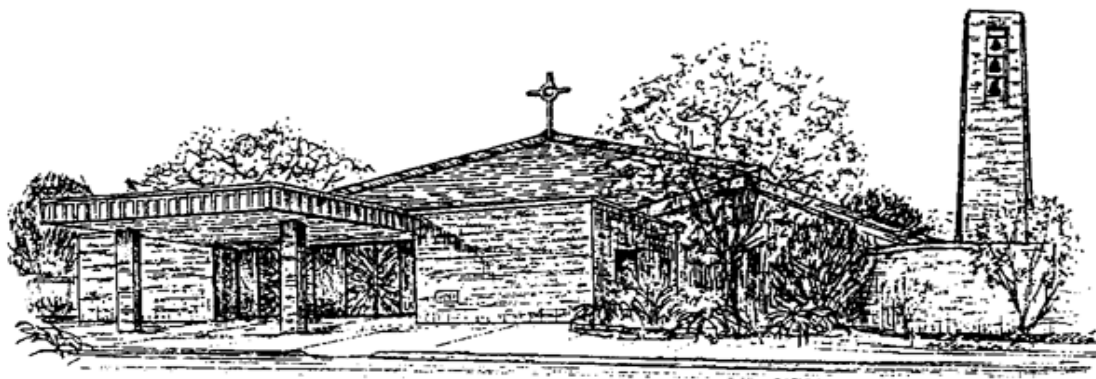

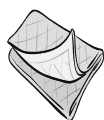

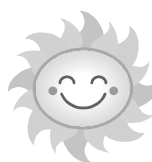


### Home Study CCD
