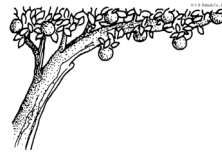
Father's Day Prayer

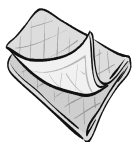

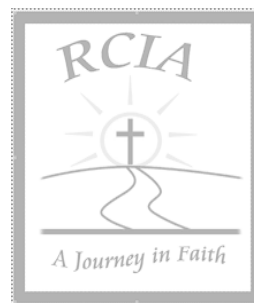

A Catholic Philosophy of Life

Four lectures will be given by Msgr. Richard Liddy, Director of the Center for Catholic Studies at Seton Hall University. The lectures will take place on four Thursdays in the summer at 7:00 pm on **June 28, July 5 and August 2** – and will take place at Stafford Hall at Seton Hall. (Park in the Parking Garage and walk a short distance to Stafford Hall).

All of us live by some philosophy, whether we know it or not. These four lectures will present a Catholic vision of life inspired by the work of Bernard Lonergan, S. J. (1904 –1984) and his writings on human consciousness. Lonergan was a Canadian Jesuit theologian whose works have had a worldwide influence. Participants will be asked to identify the elements of a Catholic and catholic, that is, holistic, vision in their own experiences. "The audience I envision for these lectures are the people getting off the train each day from New York City in South Orange and surrounding towns and involved in various professions - business, law, etc. - as well as ordinary folk open to such questions as: Who am I? What are we for? Is there a God? Is there 'grace' that heals and redeems us?"
