Striving to know, love, and serve God in all others.

This reading today is one of the most frequently proclaimed funeral readings. For that reason it presents me with a few difficulties. When we gather for a Mass, the priest is supposed to proclaim that Christ is Lord in the context of that liturgy — whether it is a funeral, Sunday Mass, wedding, Memorial, Feast Day, whatever — the message is always the same: Christ is Lord. The context changes only the content of the transmission of that core message. So, today I'm left with what I usually say... Not always easy to change gears.

Having said that, I received some great assistance from the parish in both a staff meeting and our Zoom scripture study Tuesday night. In this reading we have the great comforting power and sensitivity of Jesus coupled with this amazing response that he gives to Thomas and Philip. Jesus knows his disciples; knows us, better than we know ourselves. And even though you may detect a bit of frustration from him, his response is full of the knowledge of their needs and the disposition of their hearts.

Thank God for Thomas' doubt! Because from them Christ shows answer to our own doubt and states remarkable truth to those who know him: I am the Way,

the Truth, and the Life. And immediately following we have Philip—who seems to have not even heard Jesus say this—get it wrong again.

The SUNDAY OF EASTER


"In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you?" - Jn 14:2

Is the grace of God active in your missteps and challenges? Is his grace presented to you now? Of course it is! And yet, we do our best to confer our own grace rather than receive his. We have all decided how this pandemic should and will be ended—we've figured it all out—all of us are epidemiologists suddenly, or economists. But the question, especially for Christians is: Are you more known to him? Have you received greater power from God? Are you growing, thriving where you are planted? I don't want it to go back to normal, if normal means I forfeit the graces and gifts he has given us during this. Pray over this. You are being given a gift. Do you have the courage to unwrap it and then thank God for all that you have? Accept God's power and be perfected by it. Christ is Lord; there is only him, and those who have him lack nothing.



# **FOOD RESOURCES** DURING THE **COVID-19 OUTBREAK**

**Ontario County:** 

St. Vincent de Paul "Virtual Voucher Room" -The St. Vincent de Paul Society has opened a Virtual Voucher Room in an effort to continue to assist those in need in Ontario County. While the "regular" Voucher Room remains closed due to the coronavirus, a food voucher can be requested by calling the St. Vincent de Paul Society answering service at 585-394-3980. Clients will listen to the message, and leave their names and telephone number for a call back. Once the client has been contacted, a food voucher will be sent through the mail. **Note:** the voucher request applies to ALL who are low on food staples necessary for themselves and their families. These are not ordinary times, and we as a parish community are all here for each other. THIS IS WHO WE ARE.

St. Vincent de Paul April Update: During the month of April, The St. Vincent de Paul Virtual Voucher Room distributed 48 vouchers (food gift cards) to those most in need in our community, for a total of \$1370.

Bloomfield:

- The **Blessing Room** continues to operate and prebagged food packages can be picked up on Wednesdays from 10am - noon, Fridays from 4pm - 6pm, and Saturdays from 10am - noon. Social distancing mandates will be followed.
- Bloomfield Central School District is offering daily breakfast and lunch to students while schools are closed. A meal form must be completed in order to participate and can be found on the school website. Pick up will be from 11am -1pm at the Bloomfield Middle-High School Athletic Entrance (near the bus garage). For questions about meal distribution please contact Scott Donnelly at 657-6121 ext. 4003 or 4004.

Canandaigua:

The **CCIA** Food **Pantry** is still open their regular hours: Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays from 10am - noon and Tuesdays and Thursdays from noon - 2pm.

The CCIA Food Pantry also has a satellite food pan**try** at Zion Fellowship on 5188 Bristol St. open Mondays from 4pm - 5pm and Thursdays from 7pm - 8pm. Families may also call 394-7450 x308 if there are any questions or to make sure hours haven't changed or if they have questions. Pastor Jeff Lippincott is at Zion Monday through Friday at this time.


