Please plan to arrive at the church by 2:30 pm, thirty minutes prior to the event. Attire for attendees should be "semi-formal", comparable to what you might wear as a guest to a wedding, although you are welcome to dress "formally," but this is *not required*. All couples and their guests are invited to special post-event reception/happy hour with charcuterie, soft drinks, music and dancing immediately following anniversary blessing.
