Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) – Diocese of Trenton

Instructions for Annual Grant Application

Application period: September 1st to the 1st Monday of October

Overview:

CCHD, a Catholic Social Service program within the Diocese of Trenton, offers a grant once a year.

The grants are made possible based on the CCHD annual collection taken up parishes within the Diocese of Trenton in the Fall, usually the weekend before Thanksgiving. 75% of monies collected is sent to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops national office of CCHD and 25% is retained by the Diocese of Trenton and awarded in grants. Please keep this in mind when the collection is taken up each year – the higher the collection amount, the more grant funds available for distribution.

Each year grants are awarded in amounts of \$2,000-\$10,000 each. Grants can be received for two (2) consecutive years, after which one (1) year must pass before another grant application may be submitted.

Criteria for Grant Evaluation:

The three (3) major criteria used to award grants are the following in order of priority:

- 1) A new project or continued initiatives to enhance or provide for a foundation of stainable self-sufficiency, a *Hand-Up*; for example, use of Dynamic Budgeting; enabling an individual to learn new tools, obtain a higher paying job; or take concrete steps toward a personal goal.
- 2) A new or continued initiative with a focus on *improving* basic human needs (food, clothing, shelter, jobs etc.); for example, promoting healthier ways to use or cook food pantry items, converting a food pantry from a pre-prepared bag of food items chosen by the volunteers to an "open concept food pantry" (making *a Hand-Out* into a more respectful *Hand-Up*).
- 3) Applicants must be recognized Catholic social service agencies or parish social service ministries/outreach programs within the Diocese of Trenton.

Essential Information:

- Grants will not be given to fund building upgrades, operating deficits, research projects, or cost of fund-raising, but 20% of a grant may help fund the salary of a person needed for the project.
- Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.
- The Application form provided must be used. Other forms or formats will not be considered.
- A site visit to potential grant recipients may be necessary.
- At the end of the grant year, a report is due by grant recipients. The report form to use is on the CCHD webpage. Failure to submit a report may impact consideration of future grant applications.
- Grant money must be used within a year of receipt. At the end of that time, a determination will need to be made regarding any grant funds that have not been spent. Contact CCHD Liaison noted below.
- Grant recipients must be willing to publicize how the grant is to be used by the Diocese of Trenton.

<u>Submission and Review of Grants:</u> Applications will be due on the <u>First Monday of October</u> each year and will be reviewed by the diocesan grants review committee. Applicants will be notified in November.
