Scouting America Program Descriptions

Light of Christ (Tiger and Wolf Cub Scouts): The purpose of the Light of Christ emblem program is to help the Cub Scout develop a personal relationship with Jesus. With the parents' active assistance and participation in this program, it is hoped that the Cub will come to see Jesus as a real person and friend.

Parvuli Dei (Bear and Webelos Scouts): The purpose of the Parvuli Dei (Children of God) emblem program is to help Cub Scouts explore a wide range of activities in order to discover the presence of God in their daily lives as members of their families and parishes, and also to develop a good, positive self-image through the contributions they can make to their family, pack and community.

Ad Altare Dei (Scouts 7th grade and older): The purpose of the Ad Altare Dei (to the altar of God) emblem program is to help Scouts of the Roman Catholic Rite develop a fully Christian way of life in the faith community. The program is organized in chapters based on the seven sacraments. The seven Sacraments are a primary means toward spiritual growth.

Pope Pius XII (High School/Explorers): The purpose of the Pope Pius XII emblem program is to help Scouts explore vocations (single, married, religious, ordained) and ministries in the Church as calls from God. It includes youth led discussions on current issues facing the Church and society, which are normally included as part of a Pope Pius XII retreat or day of recollection.

Girl Scout Program Descriptions

God is Love (Daisies): The God Is Love program is designed for use with Catholic Girl Scouts who are in kindergarten or first grade. The program helps Girl Scouts discover an appreciation that God created, cares for, and loves us all.

Holy Family (Brownies DOT Program only): The Holy Family program is developed by the Diocesan Girl Scout Committee to complement the catechetical efforts of the parish and families with Catholic Girl Scouts who are in second and third grades. The program is designed to help the girl to become more aware of God's presence in her daily life, especially within her home and her community.

I Live My Faith (Juniors): The I Live My Faith program is designed to help Catholic Girl Scouts who are in fourth and fifth grades to appreciate more deeply the place that God and religion occupy in their daily lives. The program is structured on the Catechism of the Catholic Church with the themes of: Belief, Sacraments, Catholic Christian Living, and Prayer. Each theme provides a variety of opportunities for young people to explore the Catholic faith including art, technology, research, drama, and prayer.

Mary, the First Disciple (Cadettes): Mary, the First Disciple is designed for Catholic Girl Scouts who are in sixth through eighth grades to enable them to "proclaim the greatness of the Lord." This is accomplished by actively involving the participants in an understanding of Mary as a model of openness and spirituality - a woman of the church. Girl Scouts will meet Mary in scripture as a young teenager, follow her journey, and watch her grow into the woman known as the Mother of God. Through interviews, role-plays, service projects, reflection questions, and prayer the program will help students also learn more about themselves.

Affirmation (Seniors & Ambassadors): The Affirmation Emblem is developed by the Diocesan Girl Scout Committee for Catholic Girl Scouts who are in ninth through twelfth grades. The Affirmation Program is developed to foster the spiritual and personal growth of the Girl Scout and to draw her into the Christian Community, the Church, as an active participant and future leader.
