Attendance Requirement - Preparing for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion & Rite of Confirmation

The parish is, without doubt, the most important locus in which the Christian community is formed and expressed. (General Directory for Catechesis, 256) Therefore, the primary context and instruction for sacramental catechesis are found in the parish community. Students, who are receiving home-based or timerelease Faith Formation at another parish, will come together for sacramental preparation with their peer group attending the class offered for the year of formation and preparation. Parents of home-based or time-release programs are also expected to participate in scheduled parent meetings for sacramental preparation.

The spiritual and liturgical preparation (catechetical formation, rites, retreats, sacramental preparation sessions, rehearsals, and parent meetings) occur throughout the formation year. Therefore, it is imperative that students registered for faith formation in years centered in sacramental preparation have the understanding that preparation does not occur outside the parish setting and its Faith Formation program. Parents should first contact the pastor and then the Coordinator of Faith Formation to register for the appropriate sacramental program.

Confirmation students preparing to complete the Sacraments of Initiation must have fulfilled the faith formation requirements prescribed for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Each student must have a recommendation from their pastor that they visibly practice their faith (regularly attending Mass and celebrating the sacraments) and are leading a life "in harmony with the faith and role to be undertaken." A student cannot be bound by any imposed or declared penalty under Church Law.

Take Courage! Our faith can lead us to new and epic places near and far. Faith can inspire a farm boy from Iowa to explore monastic life in Southern Indiana. Faith encourages the missionary to risk life and limb to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ in a faraway land. Faith can make a parent's needed response to a child's need or disappointment become a moment of love and learning. Faith gently nudges a shy person to share their beliefs with the skeptical neighbor. Faith can change, make us bolder than we ever thought possible. Faith can transfigure us to become the disciples we are called to become. In today's Gospel, Peter's faith in Jesus enables him to take the first steps out of the disciple's boat onto the water.
