Gentle reminder: please be attentive to the online ministry schedule MSP. Currently the scheduling system is being upgraded, to go live beginning with the June 1 calendar, allowing us to create new categories for ministry with more focused options for Sunday and Holy Days. For instance, lectors will now be able to sign up to proclaim the Prayers of the Faithful or select which reading (first or second) they would like to proclaim. This update should better enable our ministers to define their roles in the liturgy. Ministers, please remember to have shoulders, knees, and toes covered in reverence for the Eucharist, the liturgy, and for your brothers and sisters
