PADRE'S POST

Personal Listening Devices Our parish family continues to have the good fortune of using and upgrading to state of the art technology for the audio and visual needs both in our churches and at the parish center, including the use of a personal listening device in both churches. Currently, over 40 units are in use by parishioners. Each sacristy is equipped to lend a device to a guest or to a parishioner to test before requesting a device to have and use *ad infinitum*. If a family member has or had a listening device and it is no longer in use, kindly return the device to the parish office by June 20, so it can be reissued. Recently, eight devices were added into circulation and others have requested this tool for their use. Six new devices will be purchased after July 1, if necessary. The *LISTEN Technologies* device is easy to use and comes with a complimentary earphone adapter. If your device is not transmitting well, check that it is operating on channel J2 or request an earphone adaptor (wire pinched or broken) from a weekend sacristan before Mass.

PA System Recalibration at St. Meinrad Thank you for your continued patience as the audio technicians recalibrate the church's sound processor. A few months ago it was discovered that the mixer located in the sacristy was having trouble holding of steady current to power and support the sanctuary mics along with the soundboard and mics located in the choir loft. Thanks for all for bringing your concerns to be about the inconsistency of amplification of lectors and liturgical music ministers and about the continued inability to hear well with the use of personal listening devices. As of this week, the mics in the sanctuary were recalibrated and this weekend mics and levels throughout the church will be recalibrated during Mass with this assistance of a technician on site. I appreciate your cooperation and patience throughout this process and hope issues will be balanced and resolved by June 30.
