### PADRE'S POST

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time We hear from Saint Paul today, that kindness, compassion, and forgiveness are all ways to imitate God and the ways to follow in the footsteps of Christ. We find our way and strength to do this through the gift of the Eucharist. As the Bread of Life is broken and shared, we receive God's eternal promise that whoever eats this bread will live forever. We have to know what we eat in order to understand and experience its value. As the psalmist shares today, we echo in the Responsorial Psalm the words captured in Psalm 34, taste and see the goodness of the Lord.
