PADRE'S POST

6th Sunday in Ordinary Time St. Paul reminds us today in his Letter to the Corinthians that if our hope in Christ is limited only to this life, our worldly life, we are the most miserable human beings. Through Christ our hope is not for the with ADA compliance fixtures and access points, an electric upgrade, and to replace things of this world, though tempting, but our hope is for what is found in eternal the dated and open-coiled heating source (not a child's toy) with a more efficient, life. We hear in the gospel today the Beatitudes, this stark contrast given to a non-exposed, safe heat source, and insulation. For your convenience, provisions for a large number of people gathered by Jesus, people from Judea, Jerusalem and the temporary porta-potty have been made and will be located near the north side of coastal region of Tyre and Sidon. If we know a little bit about geography, this region where Jesus gathered with the Twelve, and this large group gathered from many places to hear Jesus' message, on a spacious Galilean hillside thought to easily hold 100,000 people, allowed people to gather from throughout the region to hear Jesus' Sermon on the Mount and to take it home with them. The Beatitudes point us to live for the Kingdom of God and for what our hope and promise is in eternal life through Christ. As Christians our way of living is different than the worlds way. We experience the pains of earthly life, (the RESCHEDULED - Sunday, February 24: Saint Meinrad Feast Day Celebration effects of Original Sin), to be reminded that our reward will be great in heaven and that there is something beyond what our ancestors in the desert experienced before the birth of Christ and the gift of salvation. A few weeks ago, I mentioned about capturing those "Holy Moments" we experience in life. The Facilities & Grounds (SB) Update The Facilities & Grounds Commission met on book we received at Christmas "The Biggest Lie in the History of Christianity" can help us discern what these moments look and feel like. In the coming week I have invited the seminarians who are interning in our parish to identify and share some of their "Holy Moments" experienced since arriving and becoming part of our parish family.
