> **Easter Sunday** A blessed Easter to all as we celebrate the day of our salvation when Jesus Christ, the true Lamb, took away the sins of the world by his passion and death! By his dying he destroyed our death, and by his rising he restored our life. This is what it is all about, the Easter mystery fulfilled, although not easy to comprehend. Yet our faith draws us in. Christ has been raised from the dead.

> For me personally, it has been a Lenten season filled with "holy moments." The "holy moments" shared among you, the moments of renewed prayer, the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, acts of private prayer, fasting and giving of alms have brought us to this beautiful moment in salvation history.

Thank you for sharing with me the "holy moments" of your Lenten journey and Immersion Trip. The group will travel to Belize June 23-29. As ambassadors of our for taking advantage of the opportunities made available to you through the parishes, they will build a 16 x 16 foot home for a family. Please keep them in your programs and activities offered. I enjoyed learning about parishioners' "holy moments" in conversations, emails and written notes – much to give thanks for. God is good. Many have found the "holy moments" spotlight, highlighting a seminarian interning or pastoral staff at our parishes, to be helpful and inspiring.

> It is a privilege to serve as your pastor and to witness your conversion - the Paschal Mystery lived out in your moments of pain and the "little deaths" of overcoming sinful habits or restoring broken relationships. And for those who experienced the sting of mortal death, it is an honor to be praying, walking, standing with you when you have said your final farewell at the hospice bed, in the emergency room, the critical care unit or at the scene of an accident. With Easter's promise, the gifts of faith, hope and love have been your stability and I continue to pray for you.

> The Christian journey calls us to change. As we live out our human vocation, we can participate in the call and mystery of discipleship or we can, like so many in the life of Christ, distance ourselves and mock and jeer others. As we renew our baptismal promises, let us pray that Christ may graciously renew us so that we can remain faithful to the Spirit, whom we have received through the waters of Baptism. As the light of Easter casts out all darkness and the blessed night when heaven and earth were sealed in the eternal Covenant through Christ's divine and human nature, let it restore all that is fragmented in our life.

> On behalf of Father John, Father Paul, the pastoral staff and coordinators, and the pastoral council, may your hearts burn with the fire of faith, as Luke recounts in his witness to the Easter mystery. Luke reminds us to accept the testimony of the two witnesses who, when they saw Jesus standing before them in his glorified body, though their eyes could not comprehend who was before them, their hearts burned with the fire of faith. As He broke the bread following the journey on the road to Emmaus, their eyes were opened and they knew it was Him. I pray that you, too, can see and feel Christ's presence in the Word we celebrate in Sacred Scripture and in the Sacrament of the Eucharist, today and always.
