### PADRE'S POST

**23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time** Through our baptismal call and renewal and the sacramentals we engage, such as dipping our hand in holy water, invoking the Holy Trinity at the beginning and end of prayer, learning from the saints and witnessing the church around us, we are reminded to follow Christ. Our gospel this weekend helps us identify this invitation, reminding us to carefully estimate the cost of worldly ventures. Jesus illustrates through his teaching that we must carry our own cross and follow. He does not say place our cross in the sand, or on our porch, or even to let go of it. We are to lift and follow. As a pastor, it is amazing to experience this through the witness so many give through their own life as a disciple. Many have carried crosses for decades and still trust in that Easter morning hope that through mercy and sacrifice, sometimes the sacrifice of personal loss or freedom that our Lord and God in the end as the psalmist echoes in Psalm 90 “In every age, O Lord, you have been our refuge.” Let us pray for one another and trust in the path set out for us while we listen to God's Word, celebrate the sacraments, and remain faithful to the call to be charitable to one another in word and in deed.
