PADRE'S POST

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time Often God gets the short end of the stick when we are weighing the facts and wondering where God might be in the daily grind of life. In this weekend's gospel, we hear the story of the prodigal son. The radical, unconditional love exhibited in the father greeting the son after his absence is illustrated in the text. This radical love is brought to life when the shepherd abandons the 99 sheep to find the one that was lost, and the woman searching for the coin. So too does God rejoice when what was lost has been found. Many years ago, I met a middle-aged man standing in the Narthex of the church before Mass. He asked if he could see me briefly before Mass, and in making the request tears began to roll down his cheeks. He asked to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation to restore his relationship with Christ and the church. In the course of the conversation, he had been discerning returning back to church, yet felt his sins were so offensive that he was unworthy of forgiveness. For some reason, waking up on that particular Sunday he knew he should return, and it would be OK. Years later, I still see this person and pray for him and his family. I will never know the whole situation, yet that intersection of time and grace allowed this man to return to the source of grace and to live his life with restored Christian dignity. How often do we take the time to examine our life, thinking about if we are worthy to be received again by God or others. What needs to happen to allow us to make the turn to return? As we begin another fall semester of faith formation, think about what you might do to deepen your faith, or return to a place of spiritual comfort and prosperity you experienced in your youth. St. Paul reminds us that Christ came to bring salvation to sinners, yet we must turn to Christ, and in doing so we will receive grace in overflowing measure. May the days ahead be filled in abundance with mind and heart set on the image of the good shepherd and that radical love of
