## Hail, Christ Our King

**T**he readings for today's feast create a collage of images that capture different characteristics of Christ's kingship. "Shepherd" assures us his kingly rule is characterized by tenderness. "King of Israel" locates him squarely within human time and space. "Image of the Invisible God" acclaims his divine origin. "Firstborn of all Creation" places him over the entire created world. "Source of all Created Things" acknowledges him as the model after which all things were fashioned. "Head of the Body, the Church" underscores the intimacy and interrelationship between him and all those joined to him through faith and baptism. "Firstborn of the Dead" acclaims his resurrection and guarantees the resurrection of those who will follow him into death.

The Gospel's image of Christ as the crucified king clearly interprets all the other images. He is a shepherd who protects his flock with his life, a king who rules with dedication despite shame and defeat, divine yet accepted death on a cross. He was God who became a

vulnerable child of earth, a simple man who offered himself as sacrifice, the one through whom we will all enjoy resurrection from the dead.

In the last words of the Gospel, Jesus opens the gates of his kingdom to a repentant sinner: "Today you will be with me in Paradise." This is what all of us long to hear, words that are empty when coming from one who has no authority, but charged with power when spoken by the one who is king over us all.

### BECOME A MEMBER

### BAPTISM

Two preparation sessions for parents and godparents are required, at least two months before the sacrament is celebrated. ### MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners desiring to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage must contact the parish office a minimum of six months before the proposed wedding date to reserve the church and other parish spaces. Visit the parish office during office hours or [inquire online](#) to begin the marriage inquiry process and to request an initial appointment to start preparing to receive this sacrament.

### WEDDING ANNIVERSARY

# The Gospel at Home

## This Week's Gospel: Matthew 24:37-44

The Church's three-year cycle of Lectionary readings begins again on the first Sunday of Advent. We start reading from Year A, which is organized around Matthew's Gospel. The prophet Isaiah's words are used prominently in Advent. They are read as the First Reading each week and are quoted by Matthew in the Gospels. We begin the new Church year by hearing Jesus speak of his coming in glory. He cautions us always to be ready for him and to live each day in the light of God.

## Exploring the Gospel Message

**Seeds (Preschool):** Your child's lesson this week features an Advent wreath on the cover. Over the next four weeks, there will be a flame to cut out and paste on the wreath candles. This wreath should be displayed where your child can see and reach it in order to paste a new flame each Sunday after Mass. Talk with your child about how you celebrate his or her birthday and relate that to preparing for the birthday of Jesus.

**Promise (Grades K-1):** Your child made a simple Advent calendar in class this week. Display the calendar and open one panel each Sunday leading up to Christmas. The class learned different ways to prepare for Christmas. Ask your child to share some of these ways. Help your child choose one or two things to do for Advent. Using the pictures as a guide, request that your child tell you the story, "The Video Game Problem." Discuss what choices Frank could have made so he could have spent time with his family.

**Good News (Grades 2-3):** In class this week, your child reviewed the Ten Commandments. Talk with him or her about how to live the Commandments. The class also performed a play to learn about the prophet Isaiah. The

words of Isaiah are used during Advent and Christmas. Ask your child to tell you how Isaiah spoke for God. Talk about ways your family can be ready for the coming of Jesus at Christmas.

**Venture (Grades 4-6):** At the beginning of this new Church year, look together at the liturgical year calendar in your young person's lesson booklet. Talk about the importance of following the life of Jesus throughout the year. Your youngster also learned about the prophet Isaiah. Have your child share Isaiah's vision with the family and discuss why peace is a necessary goal for everyone. In preparing for Christmas, plan things to do as a family. Use the Week 1 Calendar List in the lesson booklet to give you ideas for this coming week.

**Visions (Grades 7-9):** In class this week, the young people considered how they could make Jesus' birth meaningful during this Advent. As a family, brainstorm activities that will help prepare your family's hearts and home for Christmas. Make sure what you choose to do is realistic. Your youngster can share some of the ideas discussed in class. Use a large format calendar to record the activities your family completes together. Advent is also a reminder of Christ's Second Coming.

## Pray Together

Plan to have a family Advent wreath. The wreath traditionally has three purple candles and one pink, but four, all-white candles will do. During the first week of Advent, light one candle each evening. During the second week, light two; during the third week, light three. If you have colored candles, the third week is for the pink candle. All four candles will be lit during the fourth week. Say a prayer that shows how you are excited for Jesus' coming. It can be as simple as: "Come, Lord Jesus, come."

### PADRE'S POST

#### SOLEMNITY OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, the final week of the liturgical year. In this celebration, we are reminded that Jesus does not hold the same credentials as an earthly ruler, king, president, governor, or commissioner. He is not like any ruler on Earth. His love is so great for us that he died on the cross for our sins. Jesus' gift is the perpetual invitation to live in the kingdom of God where God the Father's love and the forgiveness of sin are at the heart of all gathered in His name. In today's gospel from Luke, Chapter 23, this truth is revealed at the hour of the crucifixion. Think about the scripture passages we hear each year from Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord and on Friday of the Passion of the Lord, Good Friday. The son of David, King of the Jews, the crucified Savior, reigns – Jesus is the King of Paradise.

It was the criminal hanging next to Jesus who revealed in his question His Divine Nature, "Are you not the Christ?" The crucifixion reminds us that as Jesus' opponents insult him, he shows his divine power by forgiving the criminal who knows he has sinned and believes Jesus can help him. The criminal sees Jesus as the source of salvation. Today we believe the Church is the source of salvation because Jesus is the Church and the Church is Jesus. In Jesus' weakest hour to the judging human eye, he transforms the cross from a place of death to a place of life and mercy.

Today's gospel is about a time when Jesus was seen in a powerless position, sentenced by an earthly ruler, and mocked by his own people. Even as adults, God's kingdom is sometimes difficult for us to understand. Throughout this past year, as we heard from the Gospel of Luke, beginning Advent 2021, we have listened to many parables Sunday after Sunday about what the Kingdom of God or the Kingdom of Heaven is like. The [Catechism of the Catholic Church](#) teaches: Though already present in his Church, Christ's reign is nevertheless yet to be fulfilled "with power and great glory" by the King's return to earth. This reign is still under attack by the evil powers, even though they have been defeated definitively by Christ's Passover. Until everything is subject to him, "until there be realized new heavens and a new earth in which justice dwells, the pilgrim Church, in her sacraments and institutions, which belong to this present age, carries the mark of this world which will pass, and she herself takes her place among the creatures which groan and travail yet and await the revelation of the sons of God." That is why Christians pray, above all in the Eucharist, to hasten Christ's return by saying to him: *Marana tha!* "Our Lord, come!" (CCC 671)

As St. Paul writes in his Letter to the Colossians, Chapter 1, we belong to the Kingdom of God through his Son, who has dominion over all creation. As you give thanks today and prepare to begin a new year on the First Sunday of Advent, do not let your heart be troubled or your mind exhausted trying to understand or explain the Kingdom of God to others. In this new year of grace, focus on becoming an ambassador of Christ, a friend of Jesus who is loving and forgiving. In doing God's will, you are on your way to his kingdom.

How well do you know the Act of Contrition? This beautiful prayer can help you examine and end your day before bedtime, helping you intentionally find your way back to God when you have sinned. Remember, reconciliation means "making things right again."

My prayers are with you and your loved ones as you prepare to celebrate the Thanksgiving Holiday. Suppose your travel prevents you from being present for our parish family's Thanksgiving Day Mass - Vigil Mass – on Wednesday, November 23, at 6:15 p.m. at St. Meinrad Parish. In that case, take time to find out where Mass is celebrated near you, to pause and give thanks. As is our custom, the van from Martin's Cloak (our local food pantry) will be on site before Mass on Wednesday evening to receive your items. And 100% of the offertory collection at this Thanksgiving Mass will be given to Martin's Cloak in Perry County for their mission and ministry.

Please anticipate your needs. The parish office will close on Wednesday at 1 p.m. in observance of the Thanksgiving Holiday.

As you make plans to purchase a gift for a loved one this Christmas, remember to add your parish to your list. Check with your financial advisor or instruct your IRA custodian to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from an IRA directly to your parish. It is easy to do!

A QCD remains a great way to make a tax-free gift directly to your parish or other qualified 501(c)(3) organizations, including the established local funds (**managed by the Catholic Community Foundation (CCF) and the Community Foundation Alliance of Perry and Spencer Counties**). IRA owners must be 70½ years old. In recent years some parishioners have adopted this practice to meet their annual stewardship obligations – a yearly tax-free gift to support parish ministries, programs and activities. Some, too, have taken their QCD designated as a perpetual gift to one or more parish endowments.

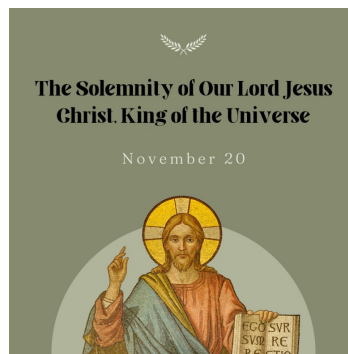

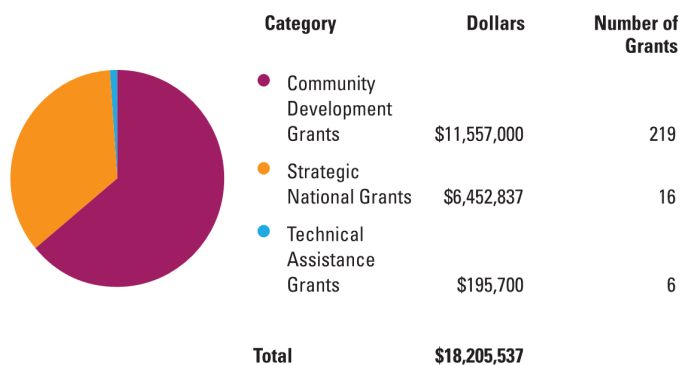

# Dear Padre,

**Can all good people go to heaven after they die, even if they haven't been a Christian? My dad is from India and grew up with another religion. The rest of my family is Catholic. I am afraid that we won't see each other again after we die.**

**P**ut your mind at ease. A person who is not a Christian can go to heaven. Heaven is not just for Christians, but for everyone who loves God and responds to God's will in his or her life.

We know that God wants all people to be saved, not just Christians. Jesus began a Church to help people achieve salvation. The Church teaches that those who seek "the truth and [do] the will of God in accordance with their understanding of it can be saved" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 1260). What we know as Catholics is that God called us into the Church. It is there that we will work out our salvation. "Since Christ died for all, and since all are called to one and the same destiny, which is divine," we must believe that the Holy Spirit makes a way for everyone, a way that only God knows (CCC 1260).

You should pray for your dad and be a faithful Catholic. Perhaps your good example will help him become a Christian. Even if he never becomes a Christian, your prayers will help him work out his salvation without the benefit of the sacraments and a believing community. If he does what is right, God will reward him.
