Stop and explore Nuremburg's charming Old Town, the center of the Holy Roman Empire and cradle of the German Renaissance.


See historic sites where emperors were crowned, saints were buried, and some of Germany's most esteemed artisans lived as you walk within centuries-old stone walls.
