Please mark your calendar.


- Archbishop Thompson will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation on Sunday, October 30, 2022.
- The Rite of Enrollment of Confirmation Candidates on **Sunday**, **August 21**, **2022**, during the 8:30 a.m. Mass at St. Meinrad Catholic Church. Sponsor or a proxy must be present to affirm your testimony and express his/her desire to support you in faith, prayer, and example.
- Also, please note the revised date for completing your Capstone Project: Wednesday, July 20, 2022.
- Candidates may submit your Capstone Project before this date. Please schedule your interview before the fall semester begins. Your interview must be completed by Wednesday, August 31, 2022. The sign up below will assist you in signing up for your interview to review and discuss your completed Capstone Project.

Looking ahead, I would like to extend an invitation to three workshops to work in a peer-to-peer setting on your Capstone Project. Parents and sponsors are encouraged to be present.
