THIS WEEK'S LESSON: ESTHER, BRAVE QUEEN



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

People who came before the king uninvited were in danger of being imprisoned or even killed, but Esther went in boldly to save her people. Heroes have the courage to make the right decisions even when it's hard. Esther 4:8-17 and 5:1-3, Esther's Request



Make this week's lesson real:

Take a walk through a movie aisle or toy aisle in a store this week. How many female action heroes do you see? Can you and your kids think of any female heroes who made tough choices like Esther?
