Message from our Pastor



Dear Parish Family,

I hope and pray you are all having a good Lent so far! This is a blessed time of year for us to grow in holiness as we seek to draw closer to the Lord. I would like to encourage you to keep up with your Lenten sacrifices and not lose hope. If you have already struggled in your Lenten promise, don't give up! It is possible to rework your sacrifice to something more manageable if you aren't succeeding. Lent is not supposed to be a time to make us feel worse about ourselves—it is a time for us to realize how much we need God's presence in our lives. This weekend's Gospel tells us that the Devil is real, and he wants us to fail in our goal to grow in holiness. He even tries to tempt Jesus, but we all know how that worked out for him! We ask the Lord during our Lenten journey to help us remain close to him. The Lord will make sure our Lenten sacrifices help us to grow in holiness, so we pray for strength to keep our eyes focused on Jesus!

Sunday Readings and Reflection

Today's Readings

First Reading — God brought us into this land flowing with milk and honey (Deuteronomy 26:4-10).

Psalm — Be with me, Lord, when I am in trouble (Psalm 91).

Second Reading — The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart (Romans 10:8-13).

Gospel — Filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus was led into the desert for forty days (Luke 4:1-13).

Almsgiving, Prayer, Fasting, and Temptation

As we begin our season of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving, the reading from Deuteronomy reminds us of our duty of almsgiving, that we “set [our offerings] before the Lord, [our] God, [and] shall bow down in [God's] presence” (Deuteronomy 26:10). The reading from Romans refers us to our prayer, reminding us that “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart . . . For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved” (Romans 10:8, 13). These are comforting words, and encourage us to ask God for what we need and to aid us in our prayer. Finally, the Gospel of Luke shows us a fasting Jesus, who was tempted as we are, and who knows what it means to be human. Someone once said that temptation arises when you're tired and weary, and the devil comes along and makes a perfectly reasonable suggestion. Jesus shows us that, with his help, we too can overcome our temptations, reasonable as they may sound.

1st Sunday of Lent

"I have now brought you the first fruits of the products of the soil which you, O Lord, have given to me." (Deuteronomy 26:10)

This line from the Old Testament offers two challenges. First, do you give to God from your "first fruits," the best that you have to offer, or do you give from what is leftover? Second, do you recognize that everything you have has been given to you by God? Ask God for a grateful and generous heart, every day, in all circumstances.

PARISH BLOOD DRIVE

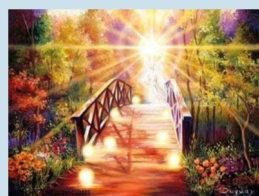

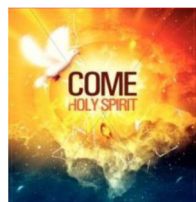


SHINE Car Wash and Operation Paint Brush

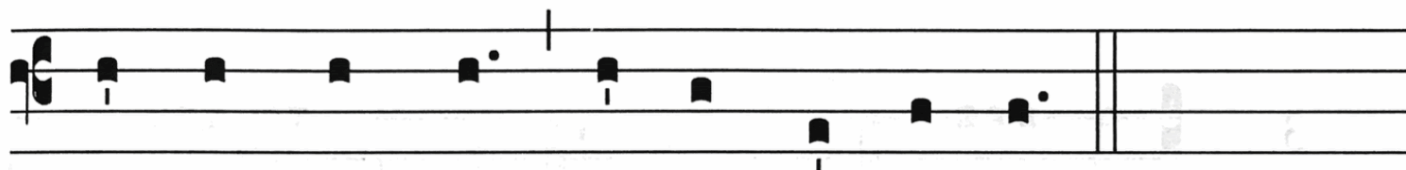

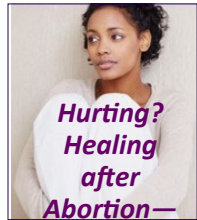
