

Get Real

Those of us who flatter ourselves that we have a "realistic" view of the world may listen to the first reading today and say, "Get real!" when we hear Luke's account of the early, Elysian days of the Christian movement. All seems to be rosy, lots of wonders are performed, everyone shares selflessly, they eat together in "exultation," and the Lord added to their numbers? Well, who wouldn't be attracted to a group like this? From the wind that swept through the upper room at Pentecost as the Spirit of God blew over the face of the waters in Genesis, and the fire that appeared over each disciple as the light appeared at the dawn of creation, Luke's intent in Acts is to show a new creation, a restoration of creation's original goodness through the working of the Holy Spirit. It is the Spirit who continues to make us into the Body of Christ. We may occasionally, like Thomas in the Gospel, say, "Get real!" but our ultimate reality in the Spirit is to work continually to make our Christian community a new creation, one in which others will find God's joy and beauty.

Stewardship

In today's first reading, the four activities of the earliest church are introduced to us as priorities of the church: devotion to the teachings of the apostles, communal fellowship, the Eucharist and prayer. The early members of the church saw themselves as devoted stewards of these activities. These were not options. They were the fruits of a genuine conversion to a life in Christ. Sharing in the Eucharist was the most intimate expression of fellowship, while the most common expression of fellowship in the New Testament was that of sharing financial resources – giving. It was not a perfect community, but one that offered evidence of God's active presence in its midst. This early community offers us an excellent example of how to better exercise stewardship in our own parish families.





St. Martha Catholic School Board is advisory and consultative to the Principal & Pastor. The school board assists the Principal & Pastor in recommendations and articulating the educational needs and aspirations of the school and school community, based on our Strategic Plan. The School Board advises and gives guidance in the areas of Catholic Identity & Academic Excellence, Enrollment & Marketing/Development & Institutional Advancement and School Leadership & Governance/Finance/Facilities.

Each board member discerned serves a term of three years and may serve up to two terms. Meetings are held the second Monday of every third month, beginning in August. Meetings are from 6:30-8 p.m. in the school library.

- ◆ Parishioner must be in full communion with the Catholic Church
- ◆ Parishioner may not be an employee or a family member of an employee of St. Martha Catholic Church or St. Martha Catholic School

CRUSADER HIGHLIGHTS

There are lots of exciting things happening within our religion curriculum, and we are happy to be able to highlight a few. Our Pre-K through Kindergarten students are enjoying the Montessori-based, hands-on learning activities in our Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Atrium. They learned about the various articles on the altar, and have been able to practice setting the altar and then reverently putting each article away. As we enter the Lenten season, these young students are learning about the holy city of Jerusalem where Jesus walked and taught, and around Easter they will have a model "Empty Tomb" to work with as they discuss Jesus' great power to rise from the dead. Our second grade students have learned about concepts relating to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, are preparing to make their First Holy Communion, and are learning about experiencing the Real Presence of Jesus. Middle school students recently participated in a "Fully Alive" retreat with St. Mary Magdalene students to understand about true happiness, and are currently diving deep into the Theology of the Body and the Ten Commandments. These students also recently lived out their faith through a service trip to the Houston Food Bank. Elementary and middle school are also participating in the Stations of the Cross each week of Lent, with 8th grade students leading the Stations.


