

Message from our Pastor



Dear Parish Family,

Two things stick out to me from the Gospel this weekend when Jesus asks about drinking from the cup. The first thing is the realization that other than the priest, no one has been able to drink from the Chalice at Mass since February of last year. Hopefully, someday we will return to being able to distribute the Precious Blood during Mass to participate in the fuller sign of the Eucharistic banquet. It is a sad reminder that the global pandemic is still greatly affecting our lives over a year and a half later, so we still have lots of people to pray for.

The second thing that stands out is the response of the disciples when Jesus asks if they can drink from his cup. They think that drinking from the cup of Jesus isn't very hard, but Jesus means something far different! When he asks "can you drink from the cup that I drink" he really means, "Are you willing to suffer greatly and lose your life by choosing to follow me?" Jesus knows that they aren't ready right there in that moment. Eventually, the Apostles get there and give their lives for the faith, but there is still a lot they had to learn and go through before they were ready to drink from the cup that Jesus drank from. The question is for us as well: are we willing to follow Jesus wherever he wants us to go? We pray for the courage that we too may be able to drink from His chalice!

Sunday Readings and Reflection

Today's Readings

First Reading — My servant shall justify many, and their guilt he shall bear (Isaiah 53:10-11).

Psalms — Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you (Psalm 33).

Second Reading — Let us confidently approach the throne of grace to receive mercy and to find grace for timely help (Hebrews 4:14-16).

Gospel — Whoever wishes to be first among you will be the slave of all (Mark 10:35-45 [42-45]).

The Humanity of Jesus Christ

All three readings today support—each in its own way, of course—a reflection on the humanity of Jesus Christ and how that humanity played a key role in the drama of our salvation. Although not chosen specifically to coordinate with the other two readings, today's second reading does in fact carry forward the theme of Christ's humanity in a remarkable way. The author of the Letter to the Hebrews highlights the solidarity that exists between Jesus and us, precisely because in his human nature Jesus has known the same sufferings and testing that are our own experience. Because he can "sympathize with our weaknesses," we can "approach the throne of grace to receive mercy." For the author of Hebrews, the humanity of Jesus was an essential requirement for his redemptive death, as well as an invitation to us to find in Jesus someone with whom we can identify in our daily struggles.

Stewardship



Stewards of a Missionary Church

World Mission Sunday is celebrated this year on **Oct. 24** and the entire month of October offers Catholics world-wide the opportunity to renew their commitment to proclaim the Gospel and to give a greater missionary focus to parish activities. It is time to reflect on the global impact of our stewardship, and to express our gratitude to missionaries who bear witness to Christ in the most remote and challenging places. The month of October can remind us that being witnesses to Jesus Christ is a stewardship responsibility of us all, and that in a world experiencing increasingly disturbing forms of alienation and indifference, our communion of faith can offer signs of hope and work to make the planet a home for all people. We are “communion” because of the gift of the Eucharist. And this gift that we celebrate in the sacrament is not something we can keep to ourselves. By its very nature it demands to be shared with everyone. That is one reason the missionary impulse of our Church has always been a sign of vitality in its unique witness of unity around the world. There are several ways you can focus on the missionary activity of the Church:

- ◆ Include petitions for the Church’s missionary work in your daily prayers.
- ◆ Increase your awareness of the wider global mission of the Church.
- ◆ Discover ways to participate in specific missionary activities taking place in our parish and diocese.
- ◆ Give generously on World Mission Sunday, celebrated this year on Oct. 24.

The Church’s work around the world is as important as the work in our own neighborhood. Let us be mindful this month that we are stewards of the Gospel, called to proclaim it to the ends of the earth, bringing hope to a world that is desperately hungry for Christ’s loving presence.






40 DAYS FOR LIFE FALL 2021
