Dear Parish Family,



Birthright of Humble needs the following items:

- ◆ **Diapers**: newborn to size 6 (The larger size is in more demand currently)
- ♦ **Baby clothes:** all sizes (Clean and gently used acceptable)
- Baby wipes: unscented (Lots of them)
- **Baby blankets:** the lighter weight ones
- ♦ Other Baby items: Ladies will know what is needed (Clean & gently used is ok)
- Similac Formula: blue cans... (This is in much demand)

We can only accept <u>new</u> car seats (we are prohibited from giving away used seats)

We can only accept <u>new</u> cribs (same reason)

Items made for a baby to sit in <u>must</u> have seat belts (same basic reasons...cannot risk harm)

If you cannot shop, <u>monetary donations are accepted</u>. This helps struggling families in need of food and baby supplies
