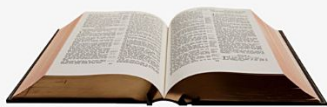

- ◆ **Baby clothes:** all sizes (Clean and gently used acceptable)
- ◆ **Baby wipes:** unscented (Lots of them)
- ◆ **Baby blankets:** the lighter weight ones
- ◆ **Other Baby items:** Ladies will know what is needed (Clean & gently used is ok)
- ◆ **Similac Formula:** blue cans... (This is in much demand)

We can only accept new car seats (we are prohibited from giving away used seats)

We can only accept new cribs (same reason)

Items made for a baby to sit in must have seat belts (same basic reasons...cannot risk harm)

If you cannot shop, monetary donations are accepted. This helps struggling families in need of food and baby supplies
