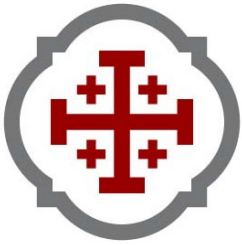
Cáliz de Vocaciones





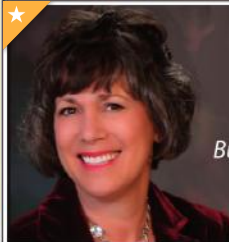
