Message from our Pastor



Dear Parish Family,

Today we hear kind of a strange parable that is filled with violence and destruction. As the landowner leases his vineyard and goes on a trip, the tenants do bad things to his property, his servants, and even his family. They have no regard for what they have been given or the people that are entrusted to help. When the landowner returns, he is justifiably angry when he hears what has happened, and he punishes the tenants! My friends, we have to be careful not to be like the tenants in this story. God has en-

trusted us with so much, and he doesn't want us to squander these gifts. If we don't do well with what we have been given, there will be consequences. The truth is, nothing we have is really ours. It all belongs to God because we are stewards of what he gives us. We can improve the things He gives us and make them better, but they still ultimately belong to him. If we think these belong to us alone, we might be like the tenants in the Gospel who use gifts for the wrong reasons. We pray that we may recognize the gifts God gives us and be willing to share those with others.

Stewardship Reflection for the 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time

This weekend's Gospel reading poses some challenging stewardship questions, particularly at a time when so many people are becoming disengaged from their faith communities. When Christ returns, will we be found working diligently in the Lord's "vineyard;" converting our own hearts into a rich harvest of love and compassion? Calling those outside our vineyard to enter into the joy of the Lord? Or will we just be living off of what the Lord has given us, but not sharing God's love with others? Jesus' parable suggests that if we are not good stewards of the gifts we've been given then the gifts will be taken away, and we will be called to give an account for our failures. We have all we need for a bountiful harvest, even during these disquieting times. What will our Lord find when He returns and asks us to give an account?

Last year St. Martha's Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul provided beds and bedding for five families in need.

Just before Christmas a request came from a refugee family living in an apartment in Kingwood for beds for two young girls. Because of space limitations, the girls were sleeping on the floor. Due to space and cost constraints our Conference searched for a bunk bed. We were referred by one of our members to a sister agency, "Sleep in Heavenly Peace" (SHIP), a ministry that provides beds and bedding for children who do not have a bed to sleep in. After we referred the family and completed an application, a two-family team from SHIP provided and installed a bunk bed and bedding for the girls on CHRISTMAS EVE!






