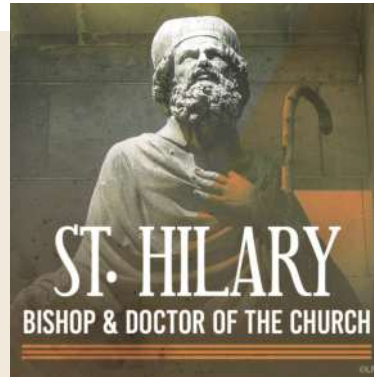

## SAINTS BIOGRAPHY

Born a pagan, St. Hilary (c. 315 – c. 367) studied philosophy and the meaning of life, eventually making his way through the bible. He became a convert and was appointed bishop of Poitiers in 353. Sometimes referred to as the Hammer of the Arians, St. Hilary defended the Nicene Creed against a popular heresy, Arianism. He was exiled to Phrygia for opposing Roman emperor Constantius II, who preferred the heresy which denies Christ's divinity. From Phrygia St. Hilary fought with his pen, zealously writing against the heresy.

Eventually he was allowed to return to Poitiers, but did so by a circuitous route, preaching against Arianism all the way. St. Hilary was likely the first writer of hymns in the West, his writings on the Trinity, Psalms and Gospel of Matthew survive today. St. Hilary was created Doctor of the Church, a title given to those who provided important contributions to theology and doctrine, in 1851 by Pope Pius IX.

## DEVOTIONS, EXPLAINED

St. Blaise Blessing of the Throat, Explained

Perhaps it's an example of divine providence that the feast of St. Blaise falls on Feb. 3 — right in the middle of cold and flu season! This fourth-century Armenian saint was a bishop and martyr and is venerated as the patron of those who suffer from illnesses of the throat.

On his feast day, Catholics traditionally receive a blessing of the throat. This blessing is administered by a priest, deacon or a lay minister who follows the rites and prayers designated for a layperson. During the blessing, the minister takes two candles that were blessed on the feast of the Presentation and makes a cross in front of the throat, saying "Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness." A priest or deacon will then make the sign of the cross.

### PRACTICING CATHOLIC

#### When Jesus Wades In

Usually, when God comes to us, we aren't ready.

We think we are. Like John the Baptist, we stand in our waters of baptism, certain of our mission. We know how it's going to go. We know what's going to be asked of us. We're sure of it.

Christ wades into the waters. And he screws up all our plans.

To be clear, I don't think John the Baptist lacks faith when he balks at the idea of baptizing Jesus. I think it is, in fact, a testament to his humility. But whatever motivated John's actions, he is — if even for a brief moment — hesitating to do the will of God. Just a few chapters after this in the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus will acknowledge that John is the greatest person "born of women" — with the caveat that even he is not perfect enough for the Kingdom of Heaven.

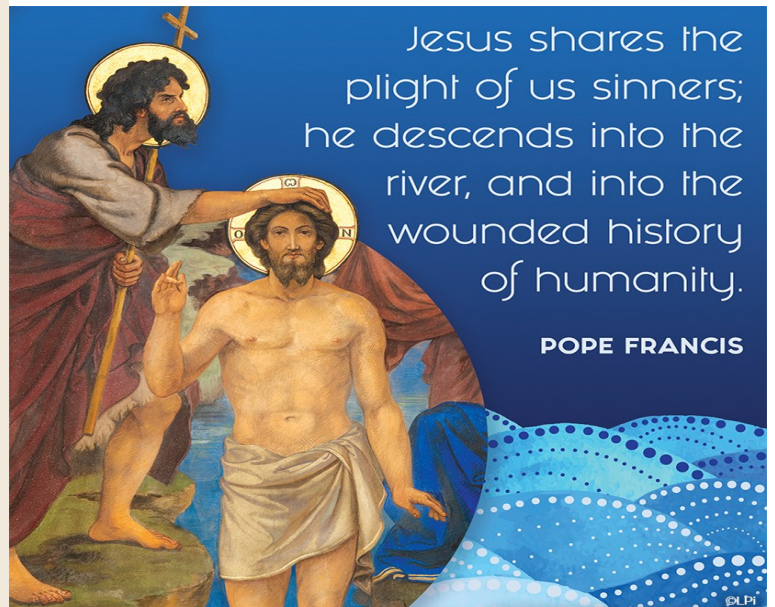
Not yet.

Jesus didn't give John an explanation as the two stood in the River Jordan. He merely said, "Allow it for now." John could have resisted further, demanding to understand why. He could have grown suspicious at the simplicity of Jesus' answer, at the strangeness of this request. He could have clung desperately to his version of How Things Are Supposed To Be, and in doing so, fostered doubt in his heart. He could have even stormed off, confused and angry.

He did none of these things, because John is, as Jesus says, the greatest born of women.

When the Holy Spirit descends and the voice of God declares, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased," he is referring, of course, to Jesus. But I think He would say the same of John the Baptist — and of all those who welcome Jesus into the waters, ready to do as he bids.

## SACRAMENT INFORMATION

### Baptism

To baptize your child at our parish, you must be a registered parishioner or live within our boundaries. For children older than age seven or Adults seeking Baptism, please contact the Parish office for information about the RCIA process.

### Holy Matrimony

Engaged couples should contact the Parish office nine to twelve months prior to the anticipated wedding date to begin the marriage preparation process at St. Angela Merici. One member of the engaged couple needs to be a Baptized Catholic.

### Anointing of the Sick/Homebound

Any parishioner who is scheduled for surgery is encouraged to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, prior to hospitalization. We will hold an anointing of the sick every other month on the second Saturday during the 9AM mass. Parishioners who are seriously ill, and the elderly may also be anointed. Please contact the Parish Office for more information.

### First Communion/First Reconciliation

Students preparing for their First Reconciliation and First Eucharist, at a minimum, must have regularly attended Catholic Faith Formation classes the year prior to their sacrament year (this could be through a parish Faith Formation program or Catholic school) and be at least seven years of age.

### Confirmation

Confirmation at St. Angela Merici must have at least one year prior preparation in Life Teen, Faith Formation or Catholic school and then complete a year of immediate preparation before receiving the sacrament and be at least in tenth grade.

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

January 11, 2026

The Baptism of the Lord

Matthew 3:13-17

Apple ran a commercial not long ago called “Behind the Mac – Greatness.” It shows artists and creators, such as Kendrick Lamar, Billie Eilish, and Lady Gaga, working behind their MacBooks. The narration says, “There’s a certain kind of person who doesn’t wait for greatness. They make it.” It’s a compelling message. There’s beauty in using our gifts with passion and purpose. But there lies a hidden weight in that idea: If you are what you make, what happens when you can’t anymore? When the project fails, the passion fades, or the spotlight moves on, where is greatness then?

Today’s Gospel offers a differing vision of greatness. Jesus steps into the Jordan River. He hasn’t preached, healed, or performed a single miracle. Then the heavens open, and the Father speaks: “You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.” It’s not a reward for success. It’s not earned. Before he does anything “great,” Jesus receives the greatness of his identity from the Father.

And so do you. At your baptism, God said the same thing over you: “You are my beloved.” That is your true identity, not constructed or earned but received. When we see ourselves and others this way, everything changes for the better. We discover a greatness that can never be taken away.

This week, reflect on your baptism: look up the date, thank God for it, pray for those baptized with you, or visit the church where it happened. Let your identity be rooted there.

### CHRISTMAS AT ST. ANGELA MERICI

A reflection by Francis Jacobs

This Advent and Christmas season at St. Angela Merici Parish unfolded as a living testimony to faith, beauty, and community—an experience marked by reverence, participation across generations, and deep joy. It was a Grace-filled Advent Journey. Throughout Advent, families were invited to light the Advent candles at each weekend Mass. This simple yet powerful gesture brought children, parents, and grandparents together around the altar, reminding the parish that the journey toward Christmas is best walked as a family of faith. Each candle kindled not only light, but anticipation, prayer, and hope. The Advent season was further enriched by the Day of Prayer and Reflection—a sacred pause amid the season's busyness. Parishioners gathered to reflect, pray, and rejoice in the nearness of Christ.

One of the most eagerly anticipated highlights of the season was the Maranatha Choir, a beautiful and inspiring collaboration of children, teen, and adult choirs. Their unified voices filled the church with awe and wonder, embodying the parish's commitment to nurturing faith across generations and celebrating the gifts of all.

Christmas Eve at St. Angela Merici radiated joy and reverence. The 4:00 PM Mass quickly filled the church, prompting an overflow Mass at 4:15 PM in the Parish Life Center, a testament to the vibrant life of the parish. A 6:00 PM Christmas Eve Mass followed, leading into a deeply moving Midnight Mass Before Midnight Mass, the choir led the congregation in traditional Christmas carols, transforming the gathering into a shared celebration of song, faith, and anticipation as voices rose together in praise.

In his Christmas homily, Fr. John reflected on the origins of the Christmas crèche, tracing its roots to Saint Francis of Assisi, who introduced the Nativity scene to help believers encounter the humility and mystery of Christ's birth. Fr. John recalled how Saint Francis, while praying before the San Damiano Cross, heard the call to "renew my Church." This reflection resonated deeply at St. Angela Merici, where the San Damiano Cross hangs above the main altar, drawing admiration and prayerful reflection from all who visit. Many parishioners and guests continue to comment on its powerful presence and the sense of peace it brings to the sacred space. The church itself stood as a visual proclamation of the season. The Art and Environment Committee transformed the sanctuary with elegant, prayerful decorations that enhanced the liturgy without overwhelming it—inviting worshippers to encounter the mystery of Christmas through beauty, color, and sacred symbolism.

#### United in Mission

All of these moments—prayer, music, worship, and beauty—came together as a living expression of the parish motto: "St. Angela is a diverse community united in the Mission of Christ through the Eucharist, proclamation of the Gospel, and service to the people of God." This Christmas season, that mission was not only spoken—it was lived.

### UNBOUND MINISTRY

January 24/25

In two weekends our Parish will welcome Rev. Tim Birney who will be with us to celebrate Masses and tell us about the work of Unbound, a lay Catholic sponsorship ministry that helps children and elderly in 17 developing countries. Father Birney, a priest from the Archdiocese of Detroit Michigan, served as pastor and associate pastor and led four World Youth Days to Rome, Cologne, Toronto and Sydney. 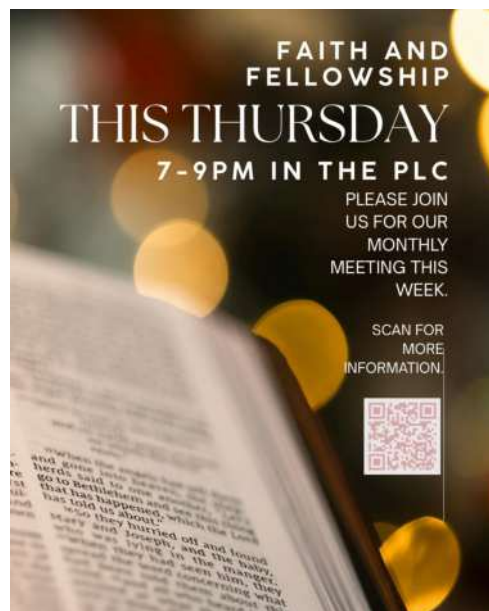
### KC FREE THROW CONTEST

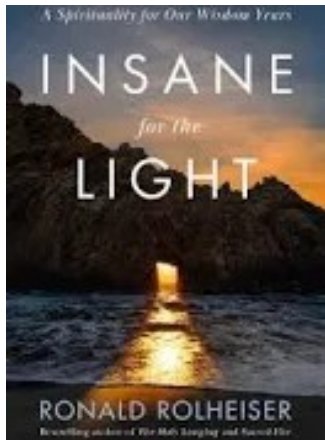
