

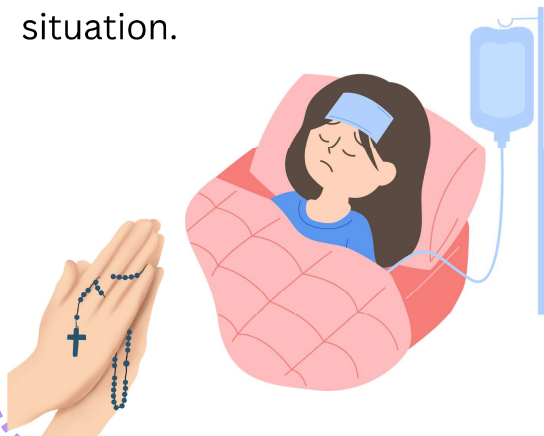
CHILD CHALLENGE

SAINT OF THE WEEK!

Saint Kateri Tekakwitha

Born in 1656, this brave girl grew up in a Mohawk village. After a sickness called smallpox took her family, she was left with weak eyes and scars.

As she grew, Tekakwitha felt drawn to God. Despite her family's anger, she was baptized and took the name Kateri. To follow her faith in peace, she traveled 200 miles through the forest to a Christian village, where she spent her life praying and helping others.

Kateri gave her whole heart to Jesus. When she died at age 24, her scars miraculously vanished, leaving her face radiant.
