

Dear Parishioners,

With the disciples in this Sunday's Gospel (Luke 11:1-13), how often have we asked: "Lord, teach us to pray..." Jesus responded to the disciples and to us: "When you pray, say 'Our Father, hallowed be your name..." This prayer contains everything we need to know and to be Jesus' followers. Recognizing the Our Father as Jesus' gift to us, the Church has always prayed it daily. No celebration of Baptism, Confirmation or Eucharist, an offering of the Liturgy of the Hours is complete without this universal prayer.

We know the words so well we could recite them in our sleep. Therein lies the danger that we may pray them like sleepwalkers making their nightly rounds. Here are two practices that might help us to pray the Our Father more fervently:

- As you pray the Our Father, what word(s) touches you? Ask yourself what is happening in your life that might be the connection.
- Each day this week take a phrase from the Our Father and reflect upon it.
- At the end of the week, pray the entire prayer and see if there are any new insights from your week-long meditation.

One of St. Teresa of Avila nuns asked how she could become a saint. St. Teresa is reported to have said: "Say the Our Father slowly and take a lifetime to recite it completely."
