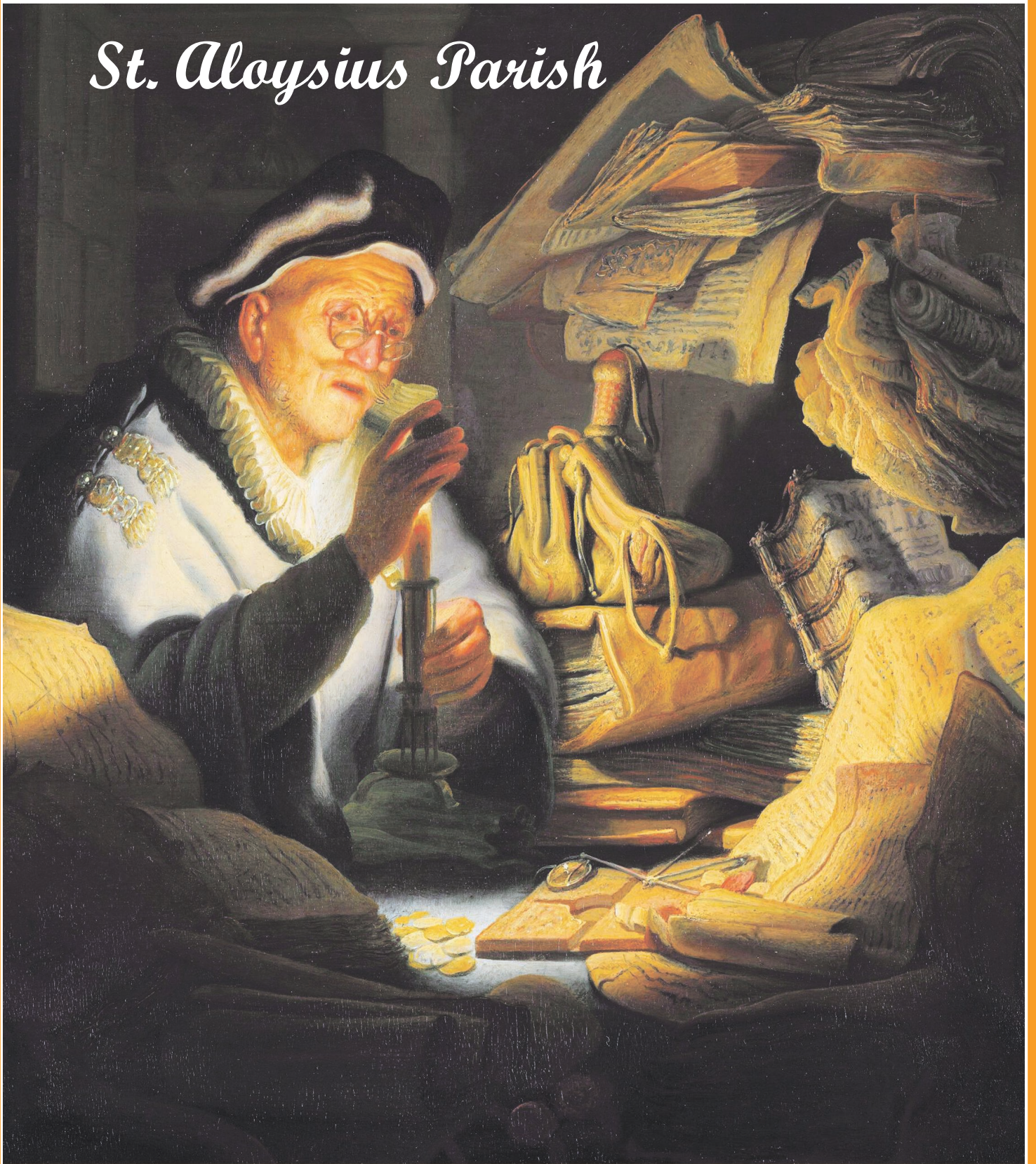

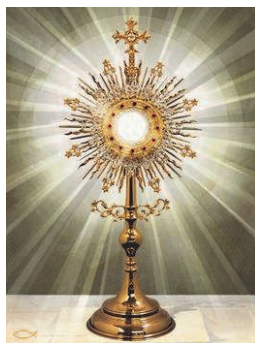

Dear Parishioners,

This is one of those Sundays in which the three readings are connected with one main idea. They invite us to reflect on what God is telling us.

In the first reading from the book of Ecclesiastes we find that there is vanity and anxiety about many things. We find that the person fighting and working for these things is happy but ultimately is leaving his accomplishments to others.

In the second reading from the letter of Saint Paul to the Colossians, the Apostle Saint Paul is telling us "Seek what is above..., think of what is above, not of what is on Earth." This is an invitation to overcome the desire to receive what is immediate, and gives us quick satisfaction but to ultimately find the long term plans that belong with Christ.

And finally in the chapter 12 of Saint Luke, Jesus is inviting us to work and to worry for the things that are significant in our lives. Instead of worrying and accumulating the material things without reason, we have to pursue what brings real happiness. That doesn't mean that things are not important in our lives because we need these things in order to develop and find that happiness; but Jesus insists that we do not have to tie ourselves to the materialistic things.

Let us continue our journey in this shining summer with grateful hearts for all the blessings that we receive from the Lord.

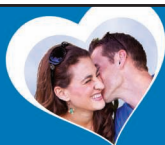
