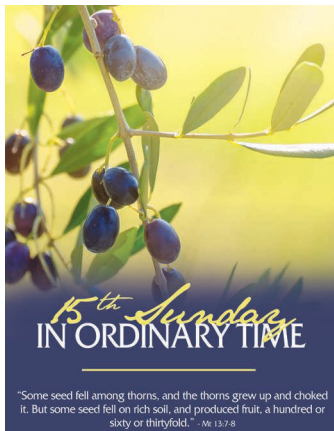

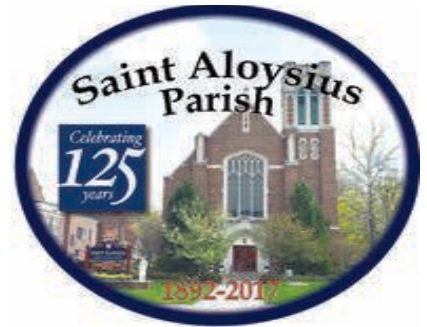

Dear Parishioner,

The four soils described in the gospel —superficial, stony, thorny, and good soil — are the types of realities during the journey of our lives but also the types of hearts, or steps to accept the word of God. We can see how Jesus answers one of the main concerns of this century's phenomena, which is, the lack of serenity in humanity's heart, or anxiety.

In the first, or superficial soil, especially in our days, when everybody runs desperately in the rhythm that society offers us, at the end of this running, the result is just stress and negative consequences for our health. There is stress on the street, on the job, at home, and many people lose the real purpose of their life. There is no more prayer or moments with the presence of God. This is the result of a superficial life without God.

In the second, or stony soil, the tribulations, trials, and difficulties of many people make their hearts as hard as stone, ceasing to believe in God. There is too much psychological and spiritual suffering, but few people stop and realize they are broken inside. Few people meditate on where they are going to end up, or what their destiny may be, or what is the reason for such a hurry in these times; there are too many worries in all the fields of our society. In front of this reality Jesus says come to me all who labor and are burdened, you will find rest for your soul.

In the third, or thorny soil, anxiety, everybody is looking for the presence and peace of God. This peace is so desired that in our days, many people search all over trying to re-encounter themselves, doing all kinds of therapy in order to recover their inner harmony. But few people explore the way to encounter Jesus, and the answer is easy; we can find Jesus in prayer, in the sacraments, contemplating the creation, listening to our conscience, but in this case especially listening to the word of God. This is possible if we be open in our minds and be humble of heart.

Finally, in the good soil, to the one who is truly humble of heart is revealed the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven. The one who believes and accepts his word, the one who acknowledges the majesty of the Lord in his life, the one who has priority for God in everything he does, the one who says Lord I am your servant here I am to do your will. Those are worthy to be called blessed, for they are the poor in spirit, they belong to the kingdom of heaven. They produce abundant fruit.

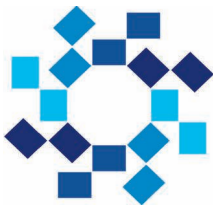

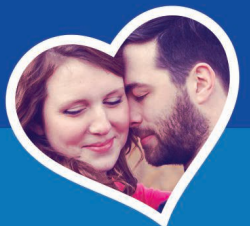
