




Dear Parishioners,

"Ready or not, here I come!" If you ever played "Hide and Seek" as a child, you are familiar with those words. That phrase perfectly fits this Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 25:1-14). There Jesus tells a parable about ten virgins who go out to meet the bridegroom. While they are counting down the minutes to his arrival, they begin to nod off and all fall asleep. Suddenly they are jolted awake by the cry, "Behold, the bridegroom! Come out to meet him!"

As it turns out only five of the ten virgins were truly ready for his arrival. They had wisely brought sufficient oil so their lamps would be burning brightly to welcome him. The other five were short of oil. When the bridegroom arrives they are running about seeking oil for their lamps.

We Christians are like those virgins at times. We are called to welcome Jesus the Lord, the divine bridegroom, who embodies God's kingdom of love, justice, and peace. He is the one who will come in glory at the end of time, and the one who comes into our lives each day. Jesus Christ comes in word and sacrament and in his Church. He comes in the poor and the powerless who cross our path. And he comes in the circumstances and events of daily life.

Those who are wise are ready to welcome and receive him. They are ready with lamps burning brightly with the oil of faith, love, and good works. The foolish are caught unprepared, their lamps are dim and their oil flasks are empty. The wise among us are those who live each day ready to welcome the Lord. The wise ones are those who start each day picturing the Lord saying "Ready or not, here I come!" Or as the Gospel puts it "Therefore, stay awake for you know neither the day nor the hour."
