FAITH QUEST-Wednesday, Mar. 21:

Faith Quest on Wednesday March 21st, 7:30 to 9 p.m. at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament parish in Roseland.

Prayer and Spirituality: “The Gift of Our Stories: Christian Spirituality and Evangelization in Our Social Media World” with Fr. Antonio “Tony” Ricarte, parochial vicar of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament. “Let me tell you a story....” Our Christian faith all began with a story – the Story of Jesus especially of his suffering, crucifixion, death and resurrection as remembered and recounted by the first disciples. Since then, that pivotal story triggered multi-faceted personal and communal stories of conversion and transformation, love, hope, salvation, etc. across the boundaries of lands and centuries. In his presentation, Fr. Tony hopes to bring his audience to re-discover the gift of our stories as integral to our own spiritual growth and to offer that gift to the world today. Fr. Tony earned his Licentiate in Missiology from Gregorian University in Rome with special focus on Dialogue and New Evangelization.

Understanding Sacred Scripture: “Reconciliation: Where Did That Sacrament Come From, Anyway?” with Father Thomas Dente, pastor, Notre Dame parish, North Caldwell and director of the Worship Office for the Archdiocese of Newark. When we think of sacraments like Baptism and Eucharist, we can make easy sense of their origins from the life of Jesus himself. But what about the Sacrament of Reconciliation? From the ancient “Order of Penitents” to kneeling in the dark confessional, to the modern Reconciliation Room, Father Dente will explain the origins and meaning of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Fr. Tom holds a master’s degree in Liturgical Theology from the University of Notre Dame.

Faith in Practice: “Mission Trips: El Salvador, Haiti and Jamaica” with Fr. Esterminio Chica. Father Mino is associate director, Youth and Young Adult Ministry, Archdiocese of Newark where his responsibilities involve the coordination of the Young Adult Ministry & Hispanic Youth Ministry. He has worked with young adults, juvenile detention centers, and has traveled to El Salvador on service trips with students from Seton Hall University. He has served at Saint Mary’s of the Assumption Church in Elizabeth and Saint Aloysius in Caldwell.

An offering of \$3.00 per session or \$10.00 for the four week series is requested to help defray expenses. Pre-registration is also requested. All sessions qualify for catechist certification.

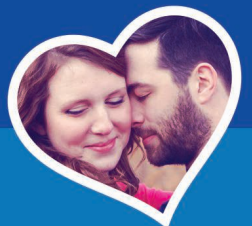
