THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM



Dear Parishioner,

Today's celebration of Corpus Christi ends a long season of special music and ceremonies. This period began with the celebrations found in Holy Week ending these last few weeks with the feasts of Ascension, Pentecost, Holy Trinity and today's celebration of the Body and Blood of Christ.

Today's celebration traces its roots to Holy Thursday, the day on which Christ instituted the mystery of the Eucharist. Today's feast reminds us of Christ's promise to be with us through the Eucharist.

One common element in the celebrations of these last four feasts is the singing of special inserts into the Mass known as the "Sequence." It is sung after the second Scripture reading. The sequence was a special insertion of extra phrases sung at the Alleluia before the Gospel. By the year 1,000 the text had been organized into rhyming verses and sung in the style of a hymn. These sequences are a type of commentary on the Feast celebrated that day and were composed by the great theologian of that time, St. Thomas Aquinas.

Estimado Feligrés,

Hoy la Iglesia celebra la Solemnidad de Corpus Christi. Conocida también como la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, esta fiesta honra a Jesucristo, verdadera y realmente presente substancialmente bajo las apariencias del pan y del vino. Esa Presencia ocurre gracias a un cambio que la Iglesia llama transubstanciación (cambio de sustancia), en el momento en que el sacerdote, durante la Consagración en la Misa, dice las palabras que el mismo Cristo pronunció sobre el pan y el vino: "Este es Mi Cuerpo", "Esta es Mi Sangre", "Hagan esto en memoria Mía". En 2023, la Solemnidad de Corpus Christi es el 8 de junio, pero se transfiere al domingo 11 de junio en algunas diócesis. Las palabras latinas "Corpus Christi" se traducen como "Cuerpo de Cristo". La Eucaristía es la "fuente y culmen de la vida cristiana" (Concilio Vaticano II, Lumen gentium, 11). En la Eucaristía, Jesús mismo vuelve a presentar Su Sacrificio en el Calvario (Lc 22,19-20; 1 Cor 11,26-29) para beneficio nuestro y se nos da en la Santa Comunión (Ex 16,4; Jn 6,1-14, 48-51), y se queda con nosotros hasta el fin de los tiempos (Lc 24,13-35; Mt 28,18-20). Viene a nosotros en esta humilde forma, haciéndose vulnerable por amor a cada uno de nosotros. Sin embargo, es Dios Mismo, y por tanto el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo merecen nuestro mayor respeto y amor, y también adoración. En el himno "Tantum Ergo" de Santo Tomás de Aquino, rezamos: Veneremos, pues, inclinados, tan grande Sacramento; y la antigua figura ceda el puesto al nuevo rito; la fe supla la incapacidad de los sentidos. San Francisco de Asís expresó: "En este mundo, no veo al Altísimo Hijo de Dios pero sí a Su Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre". La Santa Eucaristía es el más importante de los siete sacramentos. La Iglesia Católica enseña que en la Eucaristía, el Señor Jesús, verdadero Dios y verdadero hombre, está realmente, verdaderamente y substancialmente presente bajo las apariencias de pan y de vino; su presencia no es simbólica ni depende de la fe de los fieles. Los dos elementos materiales, pan y vino, son completamente transformados en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesucristo, permaneciendo solo sus apariencias sensibles de pan y vino. Así, mediante las palabras de la consagración dichas por el sacerdote, Jesús, sin dejar su presencia natural en el Cielo, también se hace presente sacramentalmente en Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad en las formas consagradas. Que el Señor nos dé la gracia de ser renovados en nuestro amor a Jesús Sacramentado!
