



Dear Parishioner,

The image of the field on which the good seed of the Gospel has been sown, but on which the enemy has sown weeds, invites us to think of what the Catechism says: "*The Church, however, clasping sinners to her bosom, at once holy and always in need of purification, follows constantly the path of penance and renewal. All members of the Church, including her ministers, must acknowledge that they are sinners. In everyone, the weeds of sin will still be mixed with the good wheat of the Gospel until the end of time. Hence the Church gathers sinners already caught up in Christ's salvation but still on the way to holiness...*" This parable of our Lord's makes it clear that evil does not come from God but from the enemy: from the clever, cunning one, who sows evil in the midst of good, so that it's difficult to sort it out neatly. Only the righteous Judge will be able to do this. That said, we should not expect immediate intervention from God to overcome evil because God is patient and merciful. The impatient servants want to uproot the weeds. Yet, Pope Francis says, "*The good God, who knows how to wait, casts a patient and merciful gaze on the 'field' of each person's life: He sees, better than us, the dirt and the evil, but He also sees the little shoots of goodness and waits confidently for them to ripen. How beautiful! Our God is a patient Father, always waiting for us, heart on hand, welcoming us in order to forgive us. He always forgives us if we turn to Him.*" God is patient because He knows that even the heart, stained with many sins, can change and bear good fruit. The owner of the field does not take evil for good. He knows what is good or bad for our health. That being said, he does not allow his servants to rush in order to afford the sinner a time for mercy. Our Lord teaches us to hold our own and to know how to hold on: what is bad can become something good. There is always reason to hope since conversion is always possible!






Estimado Feligrés,

La imagen del campo en el que se ha sembrado la buena semilla del Evangelio, pero en el que el enemigo ha sembrado cizaña, nos invita a pensar en lo que dice el Catecismo: "...la Iglesia, abrazando en su seno a los pecadores, es a la vez santa y siempre necesitada de purificación y busca sin cesar la conversión y la renovación. Todos los miembros de la Iglesia, incluso sus ministros, deben reconocerse pecadores. En todos, la cizaña del pecado todavía se encuentra mezclada con la buena semilla del Evangelio hasta el fin de los tiempos. La Iglesia, pues, congrega a pecadores alcanzados ya por la salvación de Cristo, pero aún en vías de santificación..." Esta parábola de nuestro Señor deja claro que el mal no viene de Dios sino del enemigo: del astuto, que en medio del bien siembra el mal, de modo que es difícil separar el bien. Solo el Juez Justo podrá hacer eso. Dicho esto, no debemos esperar una intervención inmediata de Dios para vencer el mal porque Dios es paciente y misericordioso. Los siervos impacientes quieren arrancar la cizaña. Sin embargo, el Papa Francisco dice: "Nuestro Dios, que sabe esperar, pone una mirada paciente y misericordiosa al 'campo' de la vida de cada uno: Él ve, mejor que nosotros, la suciedad y el mal, pero también ve los pequeños brotes de bien y espera confiado a que maduren. ¡Qué hermoso! Nuestro Dios es un Padre paciente, siempre esperándonos, con el corazón en la mano, acogiéndonos para perdonarnos. Él siempre nos perdona si volvemos a Él." Dios es paciente porque sabe que incluso el corazón, manchado con muchos pecados, puede cambiar y dar buenos frutos. El dueño del campo no toma mal por bien. Él sabe lo que es bueno o malo para nuestra salud. Dicho esto, no permite que sus siervos se apresuren, para concederle al pecador un tiempo de misericordia. Nuestro Señor nos enseña a esperar y a saber cómo esperar, ya que lo que es malo puede convertirse en algo bueno. ¡Siempre hay motivos para la esperanza ya que la conversión siempre es posible!


