Dear Parishioner

Today's Feast of the Transfiguration leads us to reflect on how we experience the Lord's presence in our lives. Often people ask the question: Where can I find God? Our God, who has become human in the person of Jesus Christ, is found not only in churches and retreat houses, but most of all He is found in the life all around us. He is found in our relationships with family and friends. Our God is a God of love and dwells in every aspect of our daily lives. We see His presence in the beauty of creation as well as in one another. We experience the life of God in all of our activities and relationships.

Understanding this changes how we seek to experience God. If God is present all around us, which He is, then we should seek Him within our everyday lives. God is more present to us in the ordinary aspects of life than in the extraordinary. It is through the normal flow of life that we experience the life of God flow through us. May we use these days of summer to experience God's life and presence in our ordinary lives!






Edith Stein: The Seventh Chamber
