The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph "...as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must forgive." - COLOSSIANS 3:13

Go to the sacrament of Reconciliation and receive God's mercy and forgiveness. Then, share the gift of forgiveness with someone – a family member, a friend or a co-worker. Pick up the phone or text someone right now.

# Dear Parishioner

All praise to our Lord Jesus for coming to earth, being born in the flesh from the womb of the most glorious and grace-filled Mary and cradled in the arms of his adoring foster father, St. Joseph, Mary's most chaste spouse!

Today, we celebrate this Holy Family of Nazareth and invoke their name and blessing on all our families. We pray in our Collect prayer that God our Heavenly Father would grant us all the graces we need to imitate the "shining example" of the Holy Family, "in the practice of the virtues of family life and in the bonds of charity," and thus aspire to "delight one day in eternal rewards."

The Holy Family is deemed the most perfect family on earth. There never was, is, and never will be another family like the Holy Family. Mary, our Blessed Mother, is the model of the perfect wife and mother; St. Joseph, chosen by God to be Mary's husband, is the model of the perfect man, husband, and father. And, Jesus, our Divine Lord, the model of the perfectly obedient child. Sarah Ciotti writes in the Divine Office: "Together, they model a Christian family focused on both 'human and supernatural virtues.' May the patterns of love and mutual care in this house of Nazareth elevate the love and peace in our own homes."

We can beg the Holy Family today and every day to imbue our married lives and our families with all the transformative and sacramental graces we need to live and practice the virtues that St. Paul extols in the second reading from Colossians. Our Lord invites us to consecrate our families to the Holy Family, to present ourselves pure and holy to God, to cherish our children, for children to honor and obey their parents, and to always have our Lord abide in our midst and guide us as he did in Nazareth.

Pope Paul VI says this in an address: "May Nazareth serve as a model of what the family should be. May it show us the family's holy and enduring character and exemplifying its basic function in society: a community of love and sharing, beautiful for the problems it poses and the rewards it brings; in sum, the perfect setting for rearing children - and for this there is no substitute."

Our Lord expects all Catholic families to be shining examples of Christian virtue in this ever-darkening world!

Acérquese al sacramento de la Reconciliación y reciba la misericordia y el perdón de Dios. Entonces, comparta el don del perdón con alguien - un miembro de la familia, un amigo o un compañero de trabajo. Tome su teléfono y llame o envíe un mensaje de texto a alguien, justo en este momento.

## Estimado Feligrés

¡Toda alabanza a nuestro Señor Jesús por venir a la tierra, nacer en la carne del vientre de la gloriosisima y llena de gracia de María y acunado en los brazos de su adorado padre adoptivo, San José, el castísimo esposo de María!

Hoy celebramos a esta Sagrada Familia de Nazaret, e invocamos su nombre y bendición sobre todas nuestras familias. Oramos en la colecta para que Dios nuestro Padre Celestial nos conceda todas las gracias que necesitamos para imitar el "ejemplo luminoso" de la Sagrada Familia, "en la práctica de las virtudes de la vida familiar y en los vínculos de la caridad", y aspirar así a "deleitarnos algún día en las recompensas eternas".




