#### Dear Parishioner

Last week we heard in Mark's Gospel the call of the first disciples and today those new disciples were with Jesus on the Sabbath as he entered the synagogue and taught. While Mark does not tell us what Jesus taught at this particular time, he does tell us the reaction to it: "The people were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority." So, what is this "authority" that moved people's hearts?

We know that Jesus' authority comes from God and is always meant to bring us closer to Him and to lead us to salvation. This encouraging message of Jesus' power from Mark's Gospel reminds us that our God has liberated us from sin and death. We are reminded that the difficulties and trials of this life are, in the end, overcome by Jesus' authority and by his healing power.

How much we all need to experience Jesus' authority and power in our lives. Only he can free us from the "unclean spirits" in our lives. Only he can free us from the sin in our lives. We have certainty that with faith in the Risen Lord, we are destined for an eternity with Him. Let us rejoice in and be open to Jesus' authority in our lives!
