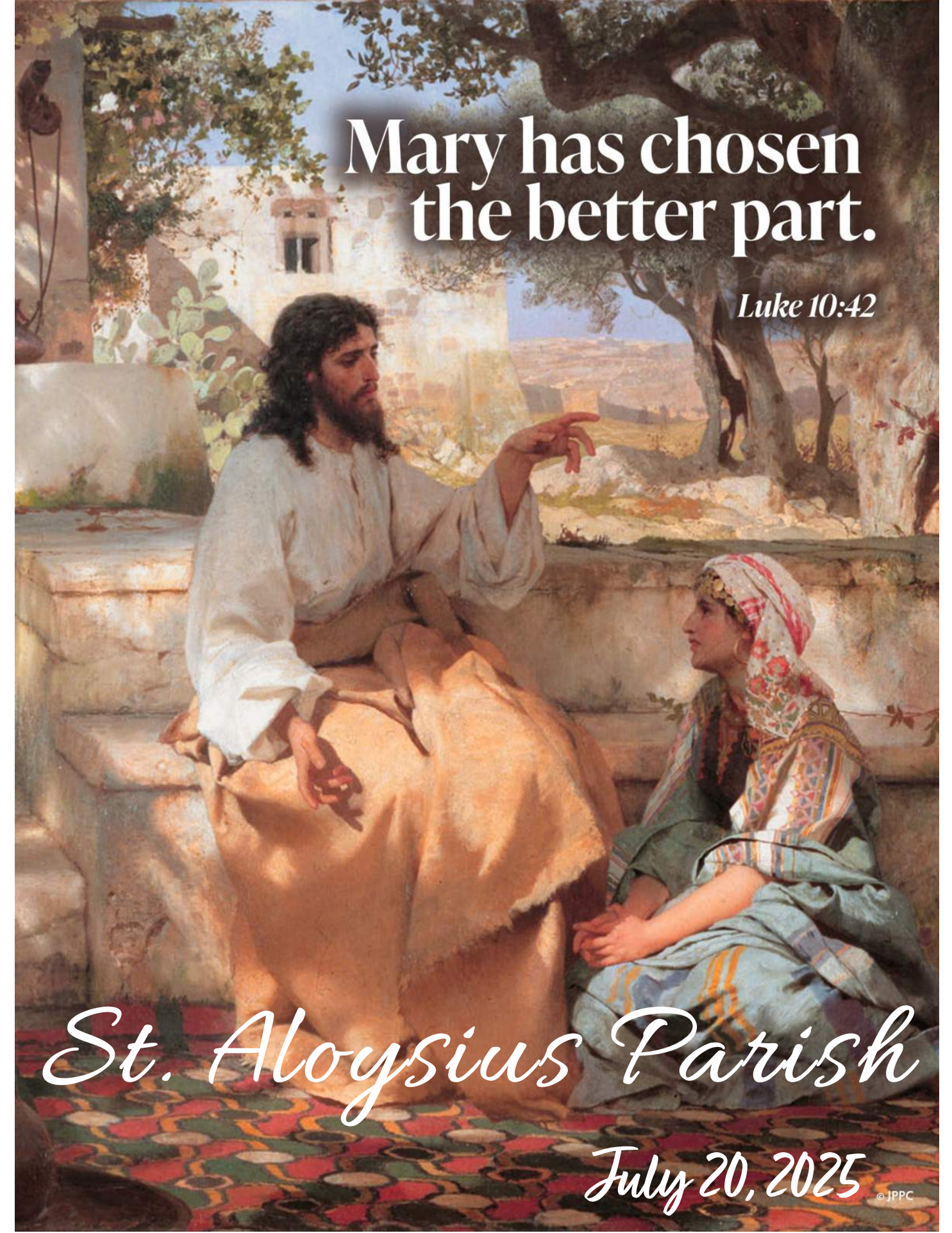

Dear Parishioner

Today's scripture readings center around the celebration of meals. We take these gatherings for granted because, in the normal course of a day, our bodies tell us it's time for a meal – a supply of energy for our bodies.

This is also very true for our spiritual energy. We gather around the Lord's table weekly (for some, daily) to replenish our spiritual energy.

In many cultures, a gathering for a special event centers around a meal. Many times, there is a spontaneous breaking into song in which the text has a relationship to the event.

I believe the first verse of today's entrance hymn spells out for us exactly why we are here today at this Meal – the Mass. When we sing this opening verse, let us deeply meditate on its meaning.

**"As we gather at your Table,
As we listen to your Word,
Help us know, O God, your presence;
Let our hearts and minds be stirred.**

**Nourish us with sacred story
Till we claim it as our own;
Teach us through this Holy banquet
How to make Love's victory known."**

Today's Gospel is the familiar story about Martha and Mary and asks the question: which is better – to cook or to listen? Perhaps both are possible.

Estimado Feligrés

Lucas 10:42 dice: "Pero una cosa es necesaria: y María ha escogido la buena parte, la cual no le será quitada." Este versículo, de la historia de Marta y María, enfatiza que priorizar el tiempo con Dios, simbolizado por la decisión de María de sentarse a escuchar a Jesús, es más valioso que el ajetreo del servicio. Destaca que el crecimiento espiritual y la conexión con Dios son esenciales y duraderos.

Jesús visita la casa de Marta y María. Marta está ocupada con las tareas del hogar, mientras que María está sentada a los pies de Jesús, escuchando sus enseñanzas. Marta se queja con Jesús de que María no la ayuda con las tareas, insinuando que la decisión de María es desconsiderada. Pero Jesús le dice a Marta que María ha elegido "la buena parte", que es centrarse en aprender de él. Esto se presenta como una opción superior a las tareas terrenales, aunque necesarias, del servicio.

"Una cosa es necesaria" - Esta frase enfatiza que lo más importante es priorizar la relación con Dios, simbolizada por escuchar su palabra.

"Buena parte" - La decisión de María de sentarse y escuchar se describe como la "buena parte" porque conduce a la nutrición y al crecimiento espiritual, un beneficio duradero.

"Que no le será quitada" - Esto resalta la naturaleza perdurable de la comprensión espiritual y la conexión con Dios. No se perderá ni le será quitada, a diferencia de las posesiones o logros terrenales.

En esencia, Lucas 10:42 enseña que, si bien el servicio y las buenas obras son importantes, priorizar el tiempo para la reflexión espiritual y el aprendizaje de Dios es una opción más valiosa y duradera.

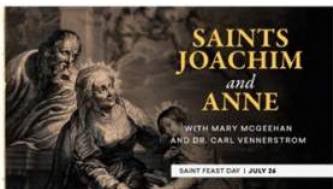

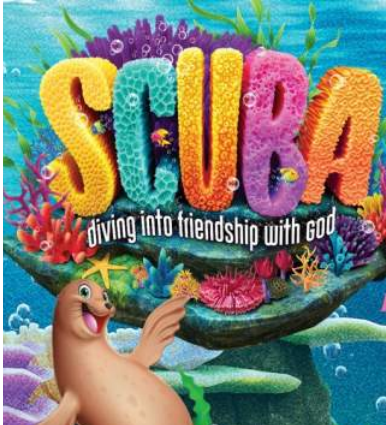

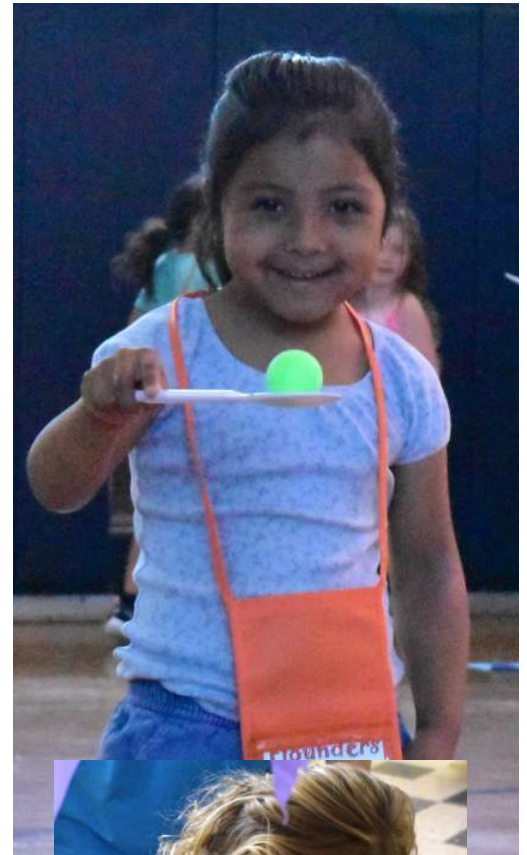
VACATION BIBLE CAMP 2025
