## Dear Parishioner

As we are all aware, the Church has placed great importance on music in its Liturgy. One area of considerable interest was that of music in congregational singing. To reinforce this emphasis, the Parish will focus on learning new Mass settings and hymns.

There is, however, another area in which the church has an impressive deposit of rich and beautiful music. It is in its great collection of choral music, ranging from as early as the eighth century to the present.

At present, our membership in the Adult Choir numbers ten. We are trying to expand that number to about 15. In a parish of our size, it would seem to be an easy task to expand to that number. The usual response is that, "I can't sing". We are inviting you to give it a try. You need only to be able to maintain pitch. We are trying a new approach adapted by many parishes. Rehearsals are before the 10:30 am Mass on Sundays, beginning at 9:40 am, thus eliminating evening rehearsals. Consider moving your hidden singing talents from the shower to the choir loft!

## Estimado Feligrés

Alguien le preguntó: “Señor, ¿se salvarán pocos?”. Él les respondió: “Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta angosta, porque les digo que muchos intentarán entrar, pero no podrán”. (Lucas 13:24)

Esta es una pregunta aterradora: Señor, ¿solo unos pocos se salvarán? Jesús no responde directamente. En cambio, da un consejo. Casi parece que Jesús evita la pregunta, como si la respuesta fuera demasiado desalentadora. Intenta animar, pero al mismo tiempo subraya la dificultad del éxito. Esfuércense, dice, por entrar por la puerta estrecha. Esforzarse es la palabra clave, ya que, al parecer, muchos intentarán entrar y fracasarán, porque la puerta es muy estrecha.

Las palabras que muchos intentarán entrar y fracasarán son inquietantes. ¿Qué porcentaje? ¿Cuántos? Hoy en día, nos gustan las estadísticas exactas. Jesús no lo dice, pero tenemos la impresión de que serán muchos. La posibilidad de fracasar es muy real. ¿Quiénes fracasarán? Probablemente, quienes no lo toman en serio, quienes no se esfuerzan lo suficiente, quienes aman algo más que a Jesús. En otras palabras, muchos fracasarán.

Él continúa diciendo que muchos que creen que están haciendo lo suficiente se sorprenderán al descubrir que no hicieron lo suficiente. Creen que sus credenciales cristianas son sólidas, pero se encontrarán con deficiencias. Le dirán a Jesús que comieron y bebieron con él, que recibieron la comunión todos los domingos. Serán testigos de cuántas veces lo escucharon predicar en sus calles, cuánto contribuyeron a la colecta, pero eso no será suficiente. Sin embargo, otros que no parecían tan buenos en la vida entrarán al Reino antes que ellos. ¿En qué grupo estaré? Jesús me advierte que solo porque siento que estoy haciendo lo suficiente por él no significa que estaré en el grupo para ser salvo. Necesito seguirlo con tanta sinceridad y honestidad como sea capaz, haciendo su voluntad y no la mía.

Hoy haré un examen de conciencia muy honesto para ver si le estoy diciendo a Jesús en algún aspecto de mi vida y si me estoy dejando llevar por la comodidad, ya que la comodidad, especialmente en la vida espiritual, es señal de que no me esfuerzo por entrar por la puerta estrecha.

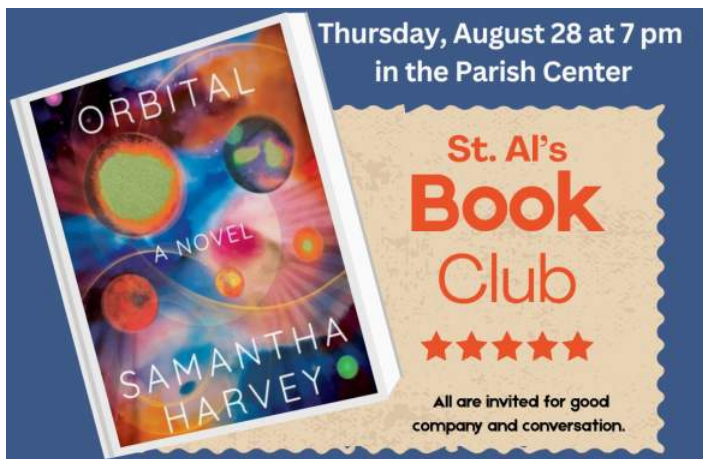

## Order of Christian Initiation of Adults

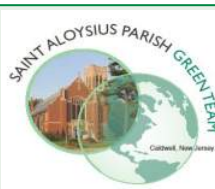

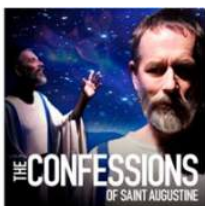
### The Confessions of St. Augustine | Littlest Saints
