There Came A Man Who Was Sent From God; His Name Was John. In family life, we learn to trust other people for protection and care. This experience of trust within the family enables children to believe

us when we testify about our faith in Jesus. John the Baptist was believed by those who heard him because he helped them to recognize Jesus in their midst. In our family life, we hope and pray that we lead one another to recognize Jesus' presence in our world.

As you gather as a family, recall that during the Advent season we are invited to pay particular attention to the signs of Jesus' presence in our world. Consider some of the signs of Jesus' presence that you have experienced.

During Advent, we remember how John the Baptist prepared the way for Jesus. Read together today's Gospel, John 1:6-8,19-28. Discuss the signs of Jesus' presence in our world that you named and explain what these signs tell us about God and God's love for us. Pray together that your family will be led to recognize that Jesus is present among us. Read and pray together the Magnificat.

My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, my spirit rejoices in God my Savior; for he has looked with favor on his lowly servant. From this day all generations will call me blessed: the Almighty has done great things for me, and holy is his Name.

He has mercy on those who fear him in every generation.

He has shown the strength of his arm, he has scattered the proud in their conceit. He has cast down the mighty from their thrones, and has lifted up the lowly.

He has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich he has sent away empty. He has come to the help of his servant Israel for he has remembered his promise of mercy, the promise he made to our fathers, to Abraham and his children forever.

Mass Intentions and Presentation of the Gifts of Bread and Wine



The long standing practice here at our parish has been that there may be up to two families "scheduled" to remember

their loved ones at each of the weekday and weekend Masses.

During the Saturday Evening Vigil Mass at 5:00 PM, as well as during the Sunday Morning Masses at 8:00 AM, 10:00 AM and 11:30AM, those who are "scheduled" to remember their loved ones are provided with the opportunity to take part in the offertory procession by presenting the gifts of bread and wine.

If there is only one family "scheduled" to remember their loved one(s) at a particular Mass, then two people from that family may participate in the offertory procession. However, if there are two families scheduled to remember their loved ones during a particular Mass, then only one person from each family may participate in the offertory procession.

If you would like to participate in the offertory procession but are not sure if there is more than one family remembering loved ones at a particular Mass, please check the bulletin that is posted along with other information on the board that is hung to the immediate right upon entering the building.

In addition, if you would like to participate in the offertory procession, please try to notify one of the ushers so that they will know that there will be people to present the gifts of bread and wine. One of the ushers will likely be able to tell you how many people from your family may participate in the offertory processon.

Lastly, immediately after the offertory hymn is announced, those who will be participating in the offertory procession should make their way to the table upon which the bread and wine are sitting in the rear of the church. Thanks in advance for your attention and cooperation. Peace, Fr. Richard




