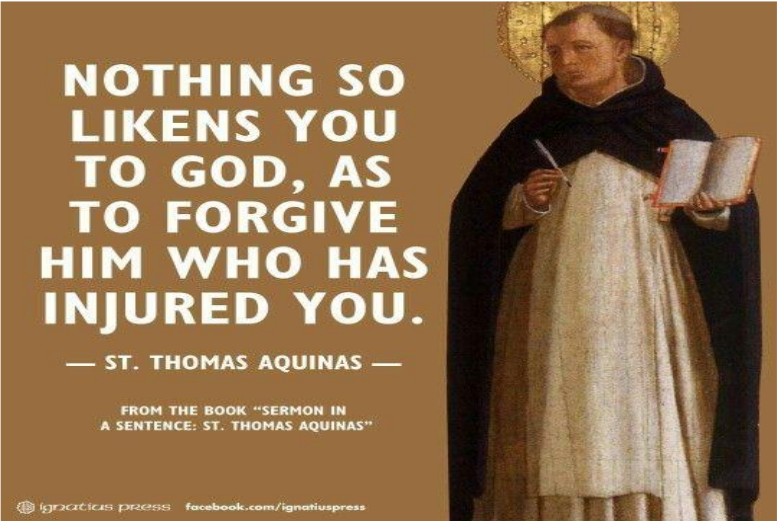

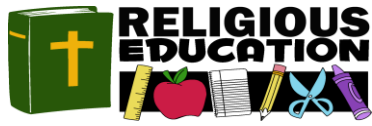


RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

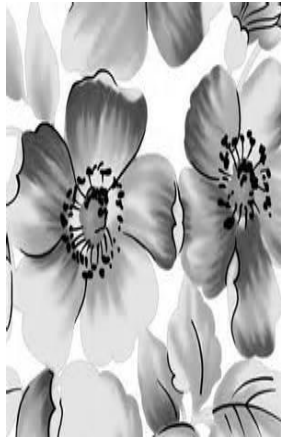
Please gather in the Convent, upstairs.
