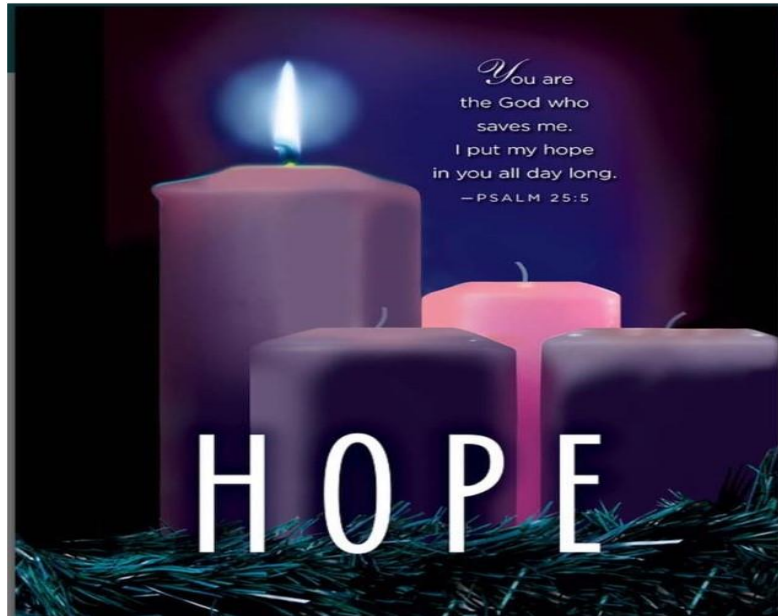

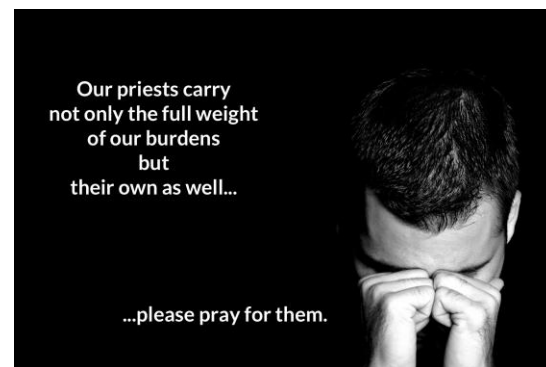

We observe all COVID Protocols while working in the store and during our sales every other Saturday.

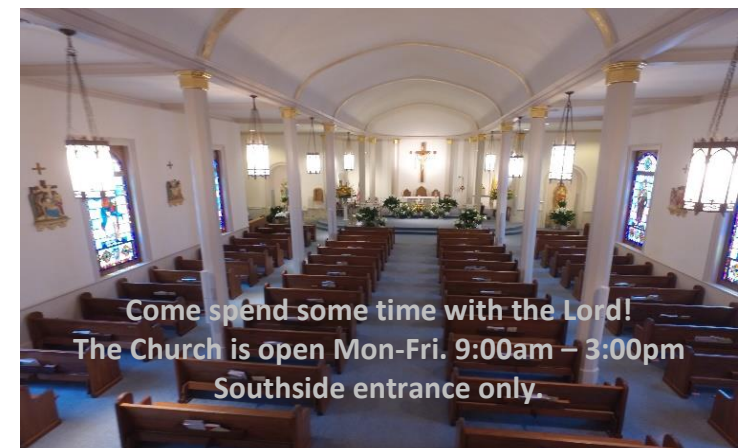
