Saint of the Week: St. Hilary of Arles

Saint Hilary of Arles, born in the early 5th century, was a prominent bishop in Gaul (modern-day France). He played a crucial role in combating Arianism, a heresy denying the full divinity of Jesus Christ, which was prevalent at the time. Hilary staunchly defended orthodox Christian doctrine, particularly at the Council of Riez in 439, where he affirmed the Nicene Creed's teaching on the Trinity.

As Bishop of Arles, Hilary worked tirelessly to promote piety, discipline, and the welfare of his flock. He emphasized the importance of clerical celibacy and moral integrity among clergy, setting a high standard for ecclesiastical conduct. Hilary's pastoral care extended beyond his diocese, as he sought to maintain unity and orthodoxy within the broader Church.

Saint Hilary of Arles died in 449, leaving behind a legacy of steadfastness in faith, pastoral leadership, and commitment to upholding orthodox Christian teaching. He is venerated as a saint in the Catholic Church, honored for his contributions to the defense of the faith and the promotion of ecclesiastical discipline and unity.

¿Sabia Que? Bullying o acoso y discapacidades

Un niño con una discapacidad, como pérdida de audición, problemas de lenguaje, problemas de aprendizaje o discapacidades físicas, a menudo corre mayor riesgo de sufrir acoso. Los niños que tienen dificultades de entender las señales sociales o el control de comportamientos físicos impulsivos también corren un mayor riesgo, ya que los acosadores pueden ver este comportamiento como agresivo, lo que provoca una respuesta agresiva. Los niños con problemas de aprendizaje también son a veces blancos fáciles de robo y vandalismo. En las escuelas, los profesores y los voluntarios deben ser conscientes de estos riesgos adicionales y estar atentos a las señales de alerta. 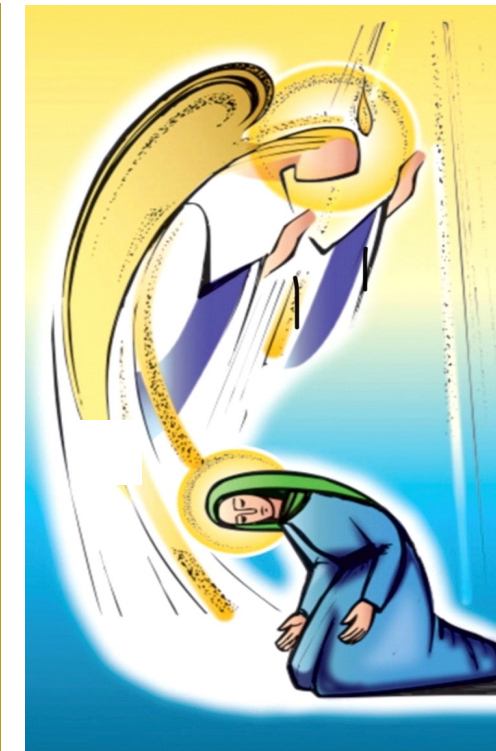

Here's a little bit of history about the early beginnings of Annunciation Church

In May 1949, Father Dominic Daly was appointed pastor by Archbishop J. Francis McIntyre with instructions to organize the Church of the Annunciation within the specified land boundaries.

The new church members were veterans and families who remained in Southern California after World War II, and established parishioners from surrounding Catholic churches. Meetings were held in various homes to aid Father Daly in search for a site to hold Mass and formulate plans for new parish ministries.

Through the generosity of Mrs. Mary Ettensperger, owner of Mountain View Dairy, a three-bay truck garage at the dairy was made available to hold Mass on Sundays.
