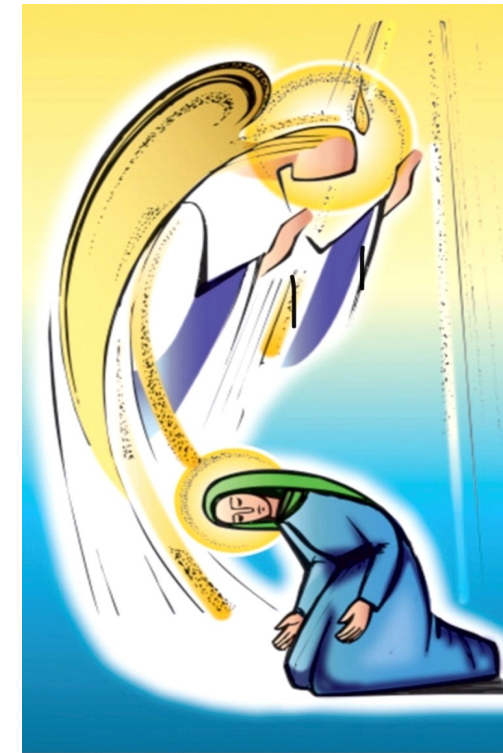

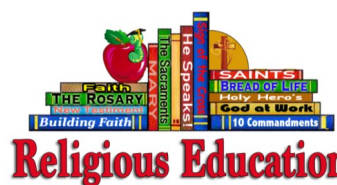


Annunciation Youth Music Ministry:

Registration for the 2024-2025 year will begin on Sunday, July 28th. Our Religious Education Office will be open that day from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 Noon and for subsequent Sundays. First-year elementary students need to bring a Baptismal Certificate. If you are registering for Confirmation, please bring both a Baptismal and a First Communion Certificate. Families with children six years and older, who are not baptized, need to provide a copy of a birth certificate. Families returning for the second year of sacramental preparation must have all previous fees paid and copies of certificates must be in the R.E. Office. Saint of the Week: Saint Victor of Marseilles

Saint Victor of Marseilles was a Roman soldier and Christian martyr who lived during the late 3rd and early 4th centuries. As a soldier stationed in Marseilles, France, Victor was known for his strong Christian faith, which he openly practiced despite the Roman Empire's persecution of Christians.

When Emperor Maximian visited Marseilles around 303 AD, Victor boldly opposed the emperor's orders to worship pagan gods. His defiance led to his arrest and torture. Despite severe beatings and imprisonment, Victor remained steadfast in his faith. While in prison, he continued to inspire other Christians with his courage and devotion.



Eventually, Victor was brought before a pagan altar and ordered to make a sacrifice. Instead, he kicked the altar, leading to further torture and ultimately, his execution by beheading. His unwavering faith and martyrdom inspired many, and he became a revered saint in the Christian tradition.

Saint Victor of Marseilles is honored as a patron saint of soldiers and those facing persecution for their faith. His feast day is celebrated on July 21st.

Did You Know? Summer safety tips: Designate "water watchers" to care for people around the water

Drowning behavior is typically fast and silent. Unless rescued, a drowning person will last only 20 to 60 seconds before submerging. To prevent drowning, it is best to swim in a lifeguarded area. Always designate a "water watcher" (<https://www.redcross.org/content/dam/redcross/get-help/water-safety/American-Red-Cross-Water-Watcher-Card.pdf>) whose sole responsibility is to keep a close eye and constant attention on everyone in and around the water until the next water watcher takes over. In the event of an emergency, reach or throw an object to the person in trouble. Don't go in or you could become a victim yourself.
